INTRODUCTION

This document is a Consent Agreement regarding Janet N. Hart-LeClerc’s license to practice registered professional nursing in the State of Maine. The parties enter into this Consent Agreement pursuant to 10 M.R.S.A. § 8003(5)(A-1)(4), 10 M.R.S.A. § 8003(5)(B), and 32 M.R.S.A. § 2105-A(1-A)(B). The parties to this Consent Agreement are Janet N. Hart-LeClerc (“Licensee”), Maine State Board of Nursing (“Board”) and the Office of the Attorney General, State of Maine. An informal conference was held on January 7, 2004. The parties reached this Consent Agreement based on information submitted by Maine Coast Memorial Hospital dated October 17, 2003 with attachments, which are attached to this Consent Agreement and marked as Exhibit A.

FACTS

1. Janet N. Hart-LeClerc has been a registered professional nurse since 1999.
2. Janet N. Hart-LeClerc is currently under a Consent Agreement with the Board imposing a probationary period of two years. The Consent Agreement is dated July 22, 2003 and is attached as Exhibit B.
3. Janet N. Hart-LeClerc admits that she failed to comply with the terms and conditions of the July 22, 2003 Consent Agreement because she failed to continue in counseling and treatment as required by her treatment providers and her employer. She also acknowledges that she misrepresented to her employer that she had been attending sessions.

AGREEMENT WITH CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

4. Janet N. Hart-LeClerc agrees and understands that this document imposes additional discipline regarding her license to practice registered professional nursing and the above-described conduct constitutes grounds for discipline under 32 M.R.S.A. § 2105-A(2)(F) and (2)(H) and Chapter, 4(1)(A)(6), (4)(3)(F) and (4)(H) of the Rules and Regulations of the Maine State Board of Nursing.
5. Janet N. Hart-LeClerc agrees and understands that the Consent Agreement dated July 22, 2003, remains in full force and effect and that this current Consent Agreement amends the July 22, 2003 Consent Agreement by extending the period of probation.



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6. Janet N. Hart-LeClerc's license to practice registered professional nursing in the State of Maine will be placed on an additional probationary period of two years with all terms and conditions of the Consent Agreement executed July 22, 2003 in force.
7. If Janet N. Hart-LeClerc fails to meet any of the obligations of this Amended Consent Agreement, the Board may take any disciplinary action, which it deems appropriate and impose any of the sanctions, including but not limited to that found in Title 10 M.R.S.A. § 8003 and Title 32 M.R.S.A. § 2105-A.
8. Janet N. Hart-LeClerc affirms that she executes this Consent Agreement of her own free will.
9. Modification of this Consent Agreement must in writing and signed by all the parties.
10. This Consent Agreement is not subject to appeal or review by the Licensee but may be enforced by an action in the Superior Court.
11. This Consent Agreement becomes effective upon the date of the last necessary signature below.

I, JANET N. HART-LECLERC, R.N., HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THE FOREGOING CONSENT AGREEMENT. I UNDERSTAND THAT BY SIGNING IT, I WAIVE CERTAIN RIGHTS. I SIGN IT VOLUNTARILY, WITHOUT ANY THREAT OR PROMISE. I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT CONTAINS THE ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND THERE IS NO OTHER AGREEMENT OF ANY KIND.


