INTRODUCTION

This document is a Consent Agreement regarding Lorna L. Hayward's license to practice practical nursing in the State of Maine. The parties enter into this Agreement pursuant to 10 M.R.S.A. Section 8003(5)(A-1)(4) and 32 M.R.S.A. Section 2105-A(1-A)(B). The parties to this Consent Agreement are: Lorna L. Hayward, Maine State Board of Nursing ("Board") and the Department of the Attorney General. The parties reached this Agreement following an informal conference on June 9, 1999 regarding information submitted by New England Rehabilitation Hospital of Portland thru letter dated June 18, 1998.

AGREEMENT

- 1. Ms. Hayward agrees to voluntarily surrender her license pending the resolution of this matter.
- 2. Ms. Hayward agrees to submit to an evaluation with an addictionologist designated and paid for by the Board.
- 3. Ms. Hayward agrees and understands that the informal conference which began on June 9, 1999 will be continued pending the results of her evaluation with the Board appointed addictionologist.
- 4. Ms. Hayward understands that she does not have to execute this Consent Agreement and that she has the right to consult with an attorney before entering the Consent Agreement.

 Modification of this Consent Agreement must be in writing and signed by all parties. Ms. Hayward affirms that she executes this Consent Agreement of her own free will.
