INTRODUCTION

This document is a Consent Agreement ("Agreement") regarding Dianne L. Hoffman's license as a registered professional nurse ("RN") in the State of Maine. The parties to this Agreement are Dianne L. Hoffman ("Licensee" or "Ms. Hoffman"), the Maine State Board of Nursing ("the Board"), and the Office of the Attorney General, State of Maine. The Board met with the Licensee in an informal conference on April 3, 2013. The parties enter into this Agreement pursuant to 32 M.R.S. §2105-A (1-A)(C) and 10 M.R.S. §8003 (5)(B) in order to resolve Complaint 2012-242.

FACTS

- Dianne L. Hoffman was first licensed to practice as an RN in Maine on August 31, 1994. 1.
- On December 7, 2012, Board Complaint 2012-242 was initiated based upon a news article dated 2. November 19, 2012 in the Bangor Daily News regarding Ms. Hoffman's summons by the Belfast Police Department for stealing drugs from an individual who had left his prescription at the Belfast Hannaford check-out, Ms. Hoffman was identified on video surveillance at the store.
- 3. On November 11, 2012, Ms. Hoffman admitted to an investigator at the Belfast Police Department that on November 10, 2012, she intentionally took prescription medication which did not belong to her from the Hannaford Pharmacy in Belfast, Maine. Ms. Hoffman stated that she intended to return it to the person named on the prescription. She later realized she had no way of locating the individual, so decided to place the prescription bottle of medication (Xanax) in the mail box located at the Liberty Post Office, assuming it would be forwarded to the owner. The investigating officer from the Belfast Police Department stated in his Incident Report (B12-5582) that his further investigation to determine whether the bottle of prescription medication was retrieved from the mail box by any of the mail carriers turned up negative.
- On February 26, 2013, Ms. Hoffman pled guilty to Stealing Drugs [17-A M.R.S. 1109(2)(B)], a 4. Class D misdemeanor, in Belfast District Court, Docket No. BELDC-CR-2013-00049. The disposition of her criminal case is deferred until February 25, 2014. Her bail conditions include completion of psychological counseling and 50 hours of community service. The attached Docket Record and Order Deferring Disposition is incorporated herein and marked as Exhibit A.



- 5. Ms. Hoffman is currently in counseling and providing voluntary care for an elderly woman through the District Attorney's Office.
- 6. Dianne L. Hoffman wishes to resolve this matter by accepting this Agreement, thereby waiving her rights to an adjudicatory hearing.

AGREEMENT

- 7. Dianne L. Hoffman admits to the Facts as stated above and admits that such conduct constitutes grounds for the Board to impose discipline against her as follows:
 - a. Pursuant to 32 M.R.S. §2105-A (2)(A) for engaging in the practice of fraud or deceit in connection with service rendered within the scope of the license issued. See also: Board Rule Chapter 4.1.A.1.
 - b. Pursuant to 32 M.R.S. §2105-A (2)(F) for engaging in unprofessional conduct that violates a standard of professional behavior that has been established in the practice for which the licensee is licensed. See also: Board Rule Chapter 4.1.A.6.
 - c. Pursuant to 32 M.R.S. §2105-A (2)(H) for engaging in unprofessional conduct as specified in Board Rules Ch. 4, §3(P) by diverting drugs, supplies, or property of a patient or health care provider.
 - d. Pursuant to 32 M.R.S. §2105-A (2)(H) for engaging in unprofessional conduct as specified in Board Rule Ch. 4, §3(Q) by possessing, obtaining, furnishing or administering prescription drugs to any person, including self, except as directed by a person authorized by law to prescribe drugs.
- 8. As discipline for the conduct admitted in Paragraph No. 7 above, Ms. Hoffman agrees to SURRENDER her Maine RN license, effective on the date of the final execution of this Agreement. Ms. Hoffman understands and agrees that as a result of surrendering her license, she no longer has a nursing license and is subject to the terms of this Agreement until and unless the Board, at her written request, votes to reinstate her license. Ms. Hoffman understands and agrees that upon receiving said request with court documentation that she has successfully met the conditions of her deferred disposition, the Board shall have the sole discretion to grant or deny such a request or to grant her a license with probation and conditions as it determines appropriate to protect the public.
- 9. The State of Maine is a "Party state" that has adopted the Nurse Licensure Compact ("the Compact"), which is set out in Chapter 11 of the Rules of the Maine State Board of Nursing. The State of Maine is Ms. Hoffman's "Home state" of licensure and primary state of residence, which means she has declared Maine as her fixed permanent and principal home for legal purposes; her domicile. Other Party states in the Compact are referred to as "Remote states," which means Party states other than the Home state that have adopted the Compact. Ms. Hoffman understands this Agreement is subject to the Compact.
- 10. Dianne L. Hoffman understands that she does not have to execute this Agreement and has the right to consult with an attorney before entering into the Agreement.

- 11. Dianne L. Hoffman shall not work or volunteer in any capacity for a health care provider as defined by Title 24 M.R.S. §2502(2) or in any position holding herself out as a registered professional nurse or with the designation "RN" while she does not hold a nursing license.
- 12. This Agreement is a public record within the meaning of 1 M.R.S. §402 and will be available for inspection and copying by the public pursuant to 1 M.R.S. §408.
- 13. This Agreement constitutes a final adverse licensing action that is reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank (NPDB) and the Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank (HIPDB) pursuant to Section 1128E of the Social Security Act and 45 C.F.R. Part 61.
- 14. Modification of this Agreement must be in writing and signed by all parties.
- 15. This Agreement is not subject to review or appeal by the Licensee, but may be enforced by an action in the Superior Court.
- 16. Dianne L. Hoffman affirms that she executes this Agreement of her own free will.
- 17. This Agreement becomes effective upon the date of the last necessary signature below.

I, DIANNE L. HOFFMAN, RN, HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THE FOREGOING CONSENT AGREEMENT. I UNDERSTAND THAT BY SIGNING IT, I WAIVE CERTAIN RIGHTS. I UNDERSTAND THE EFFECT IT WILL HAVE ON MY NURSING LICENSE. I SIGN IT VOLUNTARILY, KNOWINGLY, AND INTELLIGENTLY AND AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THIS AGREEMENT. I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS CONSENT AGREEMENT CONTAINS THE ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND THERE IS NO OTHER AGREEMENT OF ANY KIND.
