Now on this 8th day of October, 2004 the petitioner, the board of nursing, by and through disciplinary counsel for the board, Betty Wright, agrees that the Stay on the licensee's license may be reinstated.

1. The Temporary Suspension was issued on October 4, 2004 and is no longer in effect.
