DEFAULT ORDER REVOKING LICENSE

NOW ON THIS 8th of December, 2005, petitioner appears by disciplinary counsel, Betty Wright, for a pre-hearing conference on the petition. Respondent does not appear.

Wherefore, the hearing officer finds as follows:

1. Respondent was licensed as a RN. Through 9/20/2006. The board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Petitioner sent a copy of the Amended petition and notice of this hearing to respondent's last known address and service is proper.
3. Petitioner moves for issuance of a default order revoking the respondent's license.
4. The petition is hereby granted and incorporated into this order as if set forth herein.

Respondent violated the Nurse Practice Act as alleged in the petition at:

**COUNT 1:** K.A.R. 60-3-110(c) failing to take appropriate action or to follow policies and procedures in the practice situation designed to safeguard each patient.

**COUNT 2:** K.A.R. 60-3-110(s) failing to complete the requirements of the impaired provider program of the board.

**COUNT 3:** K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(2) to have been guilty of a felony or to have been guilty of a misdemeanor involving an illegal drug offense unless the applicant or licensee establishes sufficient rehabilitation to warrant the public trust,

**COUNT 4:** K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(4) to be unable to practice with skill and safety due to current abuse of drugs or alcohol;

**COUNT 5:** 65-1120 (a)(1) To be guilty of fraud or deceit in practicing nursing or in procuring or attempting to procure a license to practice nursing;

**COUNT 6:** K.S.A. 65-1120 (a) (3) to have committed an act of professional incompetency as defined in subsection (e); *Professional incompetency defined.* As used in this section, "professional incompetency" means: (1) One or more instances involving failure to adhere to the applicable standard of care to a degree which constitutes gross negligence, as determined by the board;

**COUNT 7:** K.S.A.65-1120 (6) to be guilty of unprofessional conduct as defined by rules and regulations of the board; K.A.R. 60-3-110. Unprofessional conduct. Any of the following shall constitute unprofessional conduct by (a) Performing acts beyond the authorized scope of the level of nursing for which the individual is licensed.

**COUNT 8:** K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(6), unprofessional conduct by K.A.R. 60-3-110 (e) physical abuse, which shall be defined as any act or failure to act performed intentionally or carelessly that causes or is likely to cause harm to a patient. This term may include any of the following:(3)any threat, menacing conduct, or other nontherapeutic or inappropriate action that results in or might reasonably be expected to result in a patient's unnecessary fear or emotional or mental distress;

**COUNT 9:** K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(6), unprofessional conduct by inaccurately recording, falsifying, or altering any record of a patient or agency or of the board; K.A.R. 60-3-110(d).

5. Per petitioner's request, respondent's license to practice nursing is revoked. Respondent may not practice nursing in Kansas. Respondent is to mail the license card to the board immediately.
6. Respondent shall pay the costs of the action of \$70.
7. Disciplinary counsel shall mail a copy of this order to respondent's last known address.
