ORDER LIFTING STAY


NOW on this 10th day of April comes on the Petitioner's motion to show cause why the stay should not be lifted in this matter. Petitioner appears by and through counsel Special Assistant Attorney General Diane M. Glynn. Respondent appears not. The following findings of fact are made:

1. The Petitioner was properly served with a Motion to Show Cause at the last known address provided to the Board and was served by mail on March 27, 1996.
2. Attorney for the Petitioner offers statements that Respondent has not supplied required information from the original order nor has she contacted or written the Board since March 16, 1995. Petitioner asked to admit Exhibit 1 and the same is admitted.

3. Attorney for the Petitioner offers statements that Respondent has had her Oklahoma license temporarily suspended pending hearing of the matter in Oklahoma as a result of failing to comply with her Oklahoma order requirements. Petitioner asks to admit certified copies of the Oklahoma action Exhibit 2 and Exhibit 3 and the same is admitted.

Based upon the above referenced findings of fact the stay is vacated and Respondent's license is suspended. Further Respondent is hereby ordered to return her current license card to the Board office within fourteen (14) days of service of this order.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a hearing on the Motion to Show Cause has been set by the Board for the 9th day of April, 1996, at 1:45 p.m., or as soon thereafter as time permits, in or at the Landon State Office Building, 900 S.W. Jackson, Room 106, Topeka, Kansas 66612-1230, at which time the Board will hear evidence regarding the charge against you. You have the right to appear at said hearing in person or with counsel to produce evidence and witnesses on your behalf, to cross-examine any

witness who may testify against you, and to examine such evidence as may be produced against you, pursuant to the Kansas Administrative Procedures Act.

The hearing in this matter may be conducted by a hearing panel comprised of one or more members of the Board of Nursing, or a hearing officer, and shall be conducted in compliance with the Kansas Administrative Procedures Act. Address originals of any correspondence or pleadings in this matter to:

Such application should be supported by affidavits filed with the Board no later than seventy-two (72) hours prior to the time set for hearing, except where an emergency or exceptional circumstances exist.

This present action shall not preclude the agency from initiating an action under K.S.A. 77-536 for emergency adjudication if warranted.


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
