ORDER

NOW, on this 18<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1984, the above-captioned matter comes on for hearing. Petitioner appears by and through Nancy L. Ulrich, Assistant Attorney General. Respondent appears by and through her counsel, Kenneth F. Crockett.

THEREUPON, the Board, having heard the evidence and statements of counsel and witnesses and being duly advised in the premises, finds as follows:

1. Respondent was found not guilty of Count 1 of the petition for lack of evidence. Respondent was found not to have violated the provisions of K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(3).

2. Respondent was found to have violated the provisions of K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(6) as defined by K.A.R. 60-3-110(9) by diverting Nubain from the medicine room in the Emergency Room at Stormont-Vall Regional Medical Center on or about January 17, 1984.

The Board further finds unanimously that the above act constitutes unprofessional conduct as provided by K.S.A. 65-1120.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED AND DECREED BY THE BOARD that respondent's license to practice nursing be limited to no responsibility whatsoever for any controlled substances for a period of one (1) year. Respondent shall submit quarterly reports from her administrator to the Board of Nursing stating that she is in compliance with the above limitation.
