ORDER

NOW, on this 25th day of October, 1984, the above-captioned case comes on for hearing. Petitioner appears by and through Timothy G. Madden, Assistant Attorney General. The respondent appears in person and through her attorney, Michael B. Brewer, Hines & Ahlquist, P.A., P.O. Box 67, Erie, Kansas 66733. The petitioner and respondent present evidence and rest.

THEREUPON, the Board, having heard the evidence and arguments of counsel and being duly advised in the premises, finds as follows:


The respondent has violated K.S.A. 65-1120 as defined by K.A.R. 60-3-110(a) (9) in that she diverted Demerol and Visteral from the Labette Medical Center on or about March 22, 1984.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE BOARD that respondent's Registered Nursing License be revoked and be surrendered to the Kansas State Board of Nursing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED BY THE BOARD that upon respondent's request for reinstatement of her nursing license, she be required to submit to the Board evidence that she has participated in a consistent long-term program of professional counseling and an appropriate support group. Furthermore, the Board will require respondent to abstain from the use of nonprescribed controlled substances before her license will be reinstated.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
