O R D E R

NOW on this 27th day of April, 1983, the above-captioned comes on for hearing. Petitioner appears by and through its attorney, Julia L. Young, Assistant Attorney General. The respondent appears in person, without counsel. The petitioner and respondent present evidence and rest.

THEREUPON, the Board having heard the evidence and statements of counsel and witnesses, and being duly advised in the premises, FINDS as follows:

The respondent has violated the provisions of K.S.A. 1982 Supp. 65-1120(a)(6) and K.A.R. 60-3-110(9) in that while employed at St. Joseph's Hospital in Wichita, Kansas, during July and August, 1982, she diverted controlled substances and other medication in the form of Meperidine (Demerol) and Percodan, as shown by the evidence and testimony presented at the hearing.

THE BOARD FINDS unanimously that the above acts constitute unprofessional conduct as provided by K.S.A. 1982 Supp. 65-1120(a)(6).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND DECREED BY THE BOARD that respondent's license to practice professional nursing shall be restricted to not giving any medication for the period of two (2) years from the date of this Order. Respondent shall forward her nursing license to the Board office within ten (10) days of this Order so that it can be marked with the limitation and returned to respondent. In addition, respondent shall cause quarterly reports to be submitted to the Board by her immediate nursing supervisor indicating there is no evidence of substance abuse by respondent and that she is complying with the terms of her limited license, ie., that she is not passing medication. In addition, respondent

shall cause quarterly reports to be submitted to the Board by her after-care sponsor(s) indicating her receipt of continuing treatment. Said reports shall begin July 30, 1983, and it shall be the responsibility of respondent to see that the reports are submitted to the Board.
