AGREED ORDER OF REVOCATION AND REINSTATEMENT

NOW ON THIS 8th day of March, 2013, THE ABOVE MATTER COMES

BEFORE THE Kansas State Board of Nursing (the "Board") pursuant to authority granted to the Board by K.S.A. 65-1120. The Board hereby proposes to find facts and take disciplinary action against the renewal application of Applicant by way of Agreement of the parties.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Board has jurisdiction over the Applicant and the subject matter of this action.
2. Applicant's address of record is 3914 North St. Clair, Wichita, Kansas 67204.
3. Applicant is a licensed registered nurse in the State of Kansas.
4. Applicant's license renewal application was due to the Board by November 30, 2011.
5. On September 10, 2011, well in advance of the November deadline, Applicant completed online CNE hours towards his minimum requirement of CNE hours. Believing his hours requirement to be satisfied, Applicant submitted an online renewal application to the Board.

6. After he submitted his application, Applicant reviewed the "Frequently Asked Questions" portion of the Board website. Applicant then realized that he had committed an error in calculating his CNE hours, and therefore had not submitted proof of sufficient hours.

7. Later that evening, Applicant sent an email to a staff member at the Board's licensing division, explaining the error and requesting that his application be held until he submitted proof of further hours that would satisfy the requirement. Applicant communicated with a number of Board personnel to remedy the mistake; however, Applicant's application was still processed.

8. Therefore, on or about the 12th day of September, 2011, the Board received Applicant's renewal application that contained the error.

9. Review of the Applicant's renewal application and other information gathered by the Board revealed the following information upon which this action is based.

10. Applicant answered "yes" to the question about whether he had obtained the 30 hours of Continuing Education (CNE) required for license renewal pursuant to K.S.A. 65-1117(a) and KAR 60-9-106(a).

11. Applicant is not a first-time renewal expiring within 30 months following licensure examination or a renewal expiring within 9 months of reinstatement or endorsement, either of which would be an exception to the requirement for CNE.

12. Applicant submitted his application in error and did not have the required 30 hours of CNE for renewal. Applicant complied with the requirements four days later after his renewal application was submitted.

13 Applicant waives his right to a hearing and his fifteen day appeal period, and chooses instead to go forward with revocation and reinstatement at this time.


14. Applicant consents to revocation and reinstatement of his license to practice nursing in the State of Kansas.




IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto execute this FINAL ORDER AND CONSENT AGREEMENT.
