The Board further finds that respondent has violated K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(6) as defined by K.A.R. 60-3-110(a)(9) as charged in Count 2.

That respondent has violated K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(6) as defined by K.A.R. 60-3-110(a)(4) as charged in Count 3.

That respondent has violated K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(6) as defined by K.A.R. 60-3-110(a)(4) as charged in Count 4.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE BOARD that respondent's Registered Nursing License be revoked and that the license be returned to the Kansas State Board of Nursing.
