AGREED ORDER TO STAY SUSPENSION AND LIMITATION

Now on this 8 th day of October, 2004 the petitioner by and through disciplinary counsel for the board, Betty Wright, reports it has received notification from [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] has received the release of information from Respondent's current employer, Kansas Dialysis Center. The hearing officer makes the following findings and orders:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent's address of record is 1023 SW 16TH, Topeka, KS 66614
2. The Board's request to proceed under K.S.A. 77-536, is granted due to there being a situation involving an immediate danger to the public health, safety or welfare requiring immediate state agency action. The Respondent does not object to proceeding under emergency procedures.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

3. The respondent was noncompliant with the [REDACTED] agreement by administering controlled substances while on a [REDACTED] key restriction at McCrite Plaza Health Center in May and June 2004; and by not informing [REDACTED] of her past employer and of her current employer, Kansas Dialysis Center. She was suspended from practice until she provided [REDACTED] with releases of information needed from her current employer. Respondent has provided the release required to [REDACTED] as requested in the previous Temporary Order of September 24, 2004.
4. A **limitation** is now placed on her license. Her license is valid only at the Kansas Dialysis Center since there are no controlled substances administered in this nursing position. The respondent must send in her current license card and it will be reissued with an **S** to

indicate a **stay of suspension** and an **L for limitation** will be placed on her license when it is reissued.

5. The hearing officer makes no finding on the issue of a relapse to alcohol and the matter will be set for further review on **October 27, 2004 at 9:00 a.m.**
6. Disciplinary counsel shall mail a copy of this order to respondent's last known address.
