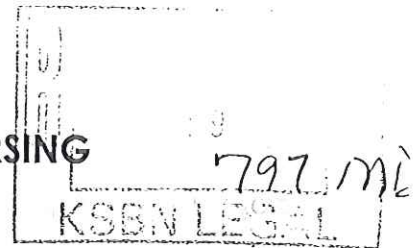

DISPOSITION ORDER

On this 19th day of March, 2001, this case comes before the hearing officer regarding respondent's license status. Petitioner appears by disciplinary counsel, Michelle Davis. Respondent appears in person and with her attorney, Martin Peck.


An order effective July 1, 1999, suspended respondent's license through the remainder of the license period ending December 31, 2000, and conditioned any subsequent renewal upon consideration of the factors for reinstatement of a license listed in the *Vakas* cases. On October 17, 2000, the parties addressed the *Vakas* factors. The hearing officer ordered a KNAP evaluation to assist in determining conditions for licensure. Said evaluation has been completed.

Based upon the agreement of the parties, the hearing officer orders that continued disciplinary sanctions against respondent's license be stayed allowing respondent to practice nursing subject to the following conditions:


1. Respondent shall satisfy the terms of her extended evaluation agreement with the Kansas Nurses Assistance Program (KNAP) and any related, reasonable recommendations of KNAP.
2. Respondent shall sign releases of information necessary for KNAP to monitor respondent and report to the board.




If respondent does not meet these conditions, then petitioner may file a motion to revoke/suspend or take other action against respondent's license or application for licensure based on the disciplinary violation established July 1, 1999.




