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**CONSENT AGREEMENT TO SURRENDER AND
REVOKE LICENSE AND FINAL ORDER**

NOW ON THIS 2nd day of June, 2010, the Kansas State Board of Nursing, represented by Assistant Attorney General, Alma A. Heckler, and the Licensee, Elizabeth J. Scott, hereby enter into this agreement and proffer evidence and the hearing officer adopts those recommendations and makes the following findings of fact and orders:

AGREED FINDINGS OF FACT

The hearing officer makes the following findings of fact based on the evidence presented and statements of the parties.

1. Licensee is licensed to practice nursing in Kansas through 5/31/2011. The Kansas State Board of Nursing (KSBN) has jurisdiction over the licensee and the subject matter of this action.
2. Licensee's address of record is 1322 S Dogwood, Ottawa, KS 66067.
3. The Kansas State Board of Nursing has the authority under K.S.A. 74-1106 et seq. to examine, license and renew license for duly qualified applicants and may limit, deny, suspend or revoke a license or authorization to practice nursing, may issue a public or private censure and levy administrative fines consistent with K.S.A. 74-1110, if a violation of K.S.A. 65-1120 is established.
4. The Board has requested that a petition be filed to take disciplinary action against the licensee's license.

5. Following a petition being filed by the Board, a hearing would also be held at a later date at which time the Board would have to prove that licensee violated K.S.A. 65-1120(a).

6. Licensee has the right to these hearings and the right to seek review of the findings from the hearings in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act and the Act for Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement of agency actions. Licensee is waiving those rights and knowingly and voluntarily entering into this agreement instead of proceeding to these hearings. This agreement will conclude Board action pending at this time against licensee's license.

7. Licensee understands that pursuant to K.S.A. 77-515, licensee may be represented at licensee's expense by, an attorney during these proceedings.

8. (a) Licensee was employed by Meadowbrook Rehabilitation Hospital in Gardner, Kansas from 1/26/2006 to 2/1/2008. Licensee was terminated following suspension and investigation of allegations that she wasted narcotics without a witness, falsified documentation of administration of medications and over-medication of patients. A review of licensee's charting showed several instances of alterations to entries, attempts to administer double the dose of medications, and incomplete entries.

(b) Licensee was referred to the Kansas Nurse Assistance Program (KNAP) by the Board. Licensee reported she is currently on disability and has no plans to go back to nursing. Licensee did not want to participate in KNAP and asked to be excused. She told the Board investigator that she was willing to surrender her license and understood her license would be revoked and such event is reportable as discipline.

(c) The board agreed to accept the surrender/revocation of her nursing license.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

9. The Kansas State Board of Nursing has the authority under K.S.A. 74-1106 et seq. to examine, license and renew license for duly qualified applicants and may limit, deny, suspend or revoke a license or authorization to practice nursing, may issue a public or private censure and

levy administrative fines consistent with K.S.A. 74-1110, if a violation of K.S.A. 65-1120(a) is established.

10. Respondent has violated the Kansas Nurse Practice Act as follows:

Count 1: K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(6), unprofessional conduct by K.A.R. 60-3-110(c), failing to take appropriate action or to follow policies and procedures in the practice situation designed to safeguard each patient.

Count 2: K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(6), unprofessional conduct by K.A.R. 60-3-110(d), inaccurately recording, falsifying, or altering any record of a patient or agency or of the board.

Count 3: K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(3), Professional Incompetency by K.S.A. 65-1120(e)(3) and K.S.A. 65-4921 through K.S.A. 65-4930, a pattern of practice or other behavior which demonstrates a manifest incapacity or incompetence to practice nursing.

Count 4: K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(3), Professional Incompetency by K.S.A. 65-1120(e)(2), repeated instances involving failure to adhere to the applicable standard of care to a degree which constitutes ordinary negligence, as determined by the board.

POLICY STATEMENT

11. The role of the Kansas State Board of Nursing is to protect citizens of Kansas.

DISPOSITION

12. Based upon this agreement, the parties agree that Licensee is surrendering licensee's license to practice nursing in the state of Kansas.

13. Based upon this agreement, and pursuant to the disciplinary remedies available in K.S.A. 65-1120, the parties agree that Licensee's license to practice nursing in Kansas is immediately revoked. Licensee shall not practice nursing in the state of Kansas.

14. Upon signing this agreement and returning it to the Board, licensee shall return licensee's license card with the agreement.

15. The Board will report this surrender and revocation to data banks, other entities, and in its newsletter. This is a disciplinary action on licensee's license. The original of this document shall be kept in the Board's agency file. This Agreement is a public record and will be reported to national disciplinary data banks. The effective date of this Consent Agreement to Surrender and Revoke is the date shown on the certificate of service.

16. If licensee does seek reinstatement of licensee's license, the agreed facts and listed violatins are admitted, licensee has waived the right to a hearing on the facts in this matter, however to receive a reinstatement of licensee's license the licensee will have the opportunity at that time to prove licensee's fitness to practice nursing in Kansas.

17. The hearing/presiding officer whose signature appears below has been designated pursuant to K.S.A. 77-514 and K.S.A. 77-526 to act on behalf of the Board/agency head and to hear discipline cases on behalf of the Board/agency head and to render either initial orders or final orders, if by agreement of both parties, in those discipline cases.

18. By their signatures, the parties hereby acknowledge this agreement.

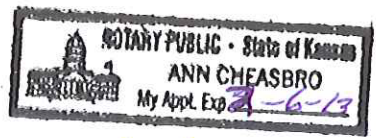

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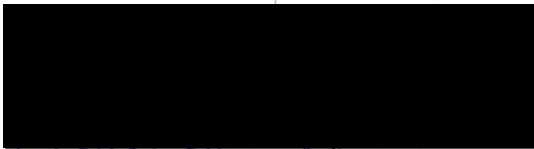
