CONSENT AGREEMENT TO REINSTATE WITH LIMITATIONS AND FINAL ORDER

NOW ON THIS 18 day of August, 2004, the Kansas State Board of Nursing, represented by Assistant Attorney General, Betty Wright, and the respondent, Glorera Muhammad Siggall, enter into the following agreement:

1. Respondent allowed her license to practice nursing in Kansas as an RN to lapse in 1999.
2. Respondent applied for reinstatement on 6/22/2004.
3. After an investigation, the Board's investigative committee found reasonable grounds to believe that respondent violated the nurse practice act and referred this matter for further proceedings.
4. The Kansas State Board of Nursing has the authority under K.S.A. 74-1106 et seq. to examine, license and renew license for duly qualified applicants and may limit, deny, suspend or revoke a license or authorization to practice nursing, may issue a public or private censure and levy administrative fines consistent with K.S.A. 74-1110, if a violation of K.S.A. 65-1120(a) is established.

AGREED FINDINGS OF FACT

5. The respondent had an action on her Missouri nursing license, Missouri Case 02-0484BN for possession of marijuana. Her Missouri nursing license was placed on probation for two years, effective April 18, 2003. Missouri Order is attached and incorporated within.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

6. Respondent has the right to a hearing for reinstatement with evidence and witnesses to establish evidence of her fitness to practice nursing and to seek review of the findings from that hearing in accordance with the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act and the Act for Judicial

Review and Civil Enforcement of agency actions. Respondent and the Kansas State Board of Nursing are waiving those rights and voluntarily entering into this consent agreement instead of proceeding to such a hearing.

The above incidents are violations of the nurse practice act. The respondent agrees that the board is prepared to prove that she has violated:

- (a) K.S.A. 65 1120(a)(4) to be unable to practice with skill and safety due to current abuse of drugs or alcohol;
- (b) K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(8) to have a license to practice nursing as a registered nurse or as a practical nurse denied, revoked, limited or suspended, or to be publicly or privately censured, by a licensing authority of another state, agency of the United States government, territory of the United States or country or to have other disciplinary action taken against the applicant or licensee by a licensing authority of another state, agency of the United States government, territory of the United States or country. A certified copy of the record or order of public or private censure, denial, suspension, limitation, revocation or other disciplinary action of the licensing authority of another state, agency of the United States government, territory of the United States or country shall constitute prima facie evidence of such a fact for purposes of this paragraph (8).

POLICY STATEMENT

7. The role of Kansas State Board of Nursing is to protect the citizens of Kansas.

DISPOSITION

8. Based upon this agreement, and pursuant to the disciplinary remedies available in K.S.A. 65-1120, the parties agree that the license card will be issued with an "L"; the license will be **limited** and respondent will be allowed to practice under the following conditions:

- a. Licensee shall comply and complete the probationary requirements of the Missouri board as described in the Missouri Order.
- b. Licensee shall send a **money order for \$70** to the Board upon entering into this agreement.
- c. Licensee will submit all random UAs provided to the Missouri Board to the Kansas Board also by simultaneously mailing them to: Legal Division, KSBN, 900 SW Jackson, Suite 1051, Topeka, KS 66612.
- d. All employer work performance reports must be submitted to the Kansas Board of Nursing also, at same address in 8 (c).

e. Licensee may not serve on administrative staff, or on faculty or as a preceptor in any accredited nursing school.

f. Notify the Kansas Board of employer changes, with names and phone numbers provided.

9.. Respondent is responsible for the costs related to satisfying these conditions.

10. If respondent does not meet these requirements the Board of Nursing may request additional sanctions against applicant's license or application for a license. Respondent would be sent notice of such action and would be entitled to a hearing as to whether she had complied with these orders, but respondent could not contest the established violations.

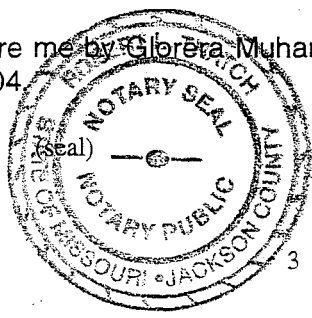
