DEFAULT ORDER SUSPENDING LICENSE

NOW ON THIS 20th day of October, 2004, petitioner appears by disciplinary counsel, Betty Wright, for a Hearing on the Petition. Respondent does not appear.

Wherefore, the hearing officer finds as follows:

1. Respondent was licensed through 8/31//2004 as an R.N. The petition was filed on 8/26/2004, the board has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Petitioner sent a copy of the petition and notice of this hearing to respondent's last known address and service is proper.
3. Petitioner moves for issuance of a proposed default order suspending license.
4. The petitioner's request is granted by default.
5. The petition is hereby granted and incorporated into this order as if set forth herein.

Respondent violated the Nurse Practice Act as follows:

- (a) K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(6), unprofessional conduct, by drug diversion K.A.R. 60-3-110(n);
 - (b) K.S.A. 65 1120(a)(4) to be unable to practice with skill and safety due to current abuse of drugs or alcohol;
 - (c) K.S.A. 65 – 1120(a)(6), unprofessional conduct by inaccurately recording, falsifying, or altering any record of a patient or agency or of the board; K.A.R. 60-3-110(d).
6. Costs of the action of \$70 are assessed to respondent to be paid to the board by cash or money order within 30 days of the effective date of this order.
 7. Disciplinary counsel shall mail a copy of this order to respondent's last known address.
