ORDER STAYING SUSPENSION OF LICENSE

Now on this 25th day of January 2005, petitioner appears by Betty Wright, disciplinary counsel, to update this case file in accordance with the terms of a previous order. On 8/11/04, respondent's license was suspended by default. The respondent had been asked by the board to provide evidence of completion of 3 hours of CNE on "Critical Thinking or ethics in nursing" and to pay the default cost of \$70.00 in order to stay the suspension. The petitioner states that respondent paid the cost of \$70.00 on 1/21/2005 and provided the original certificate of completion of 3 hours of CNE on "Nursing Ethical Decision Making" on 1/25/2005. The requirements to cure the suspension have been met, and the suspension of the license should be stayed.

It is therefore ordered that the suspension of respondent's license is stayed effective January 25, 2005.

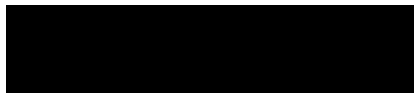
