FINAL ORDER

ON THE 10th day of December, 1998 this matter came on for hearing before the Kansas State Board of Nursing on the Respondent's Petition For Review of the Summary Order entered on July 16, 1998 and the Memorandum And Decision And Initial Order Affirming Summary Order entered on October 20, 1998. The Respondent appeared by and through his attorney Daniel F. Meara. The Kansas State Board of Nursing appeared by and through Assistant Attorney General Rex G. Beasley, Disciplinary Counsel for the Board.

Thereupon the parties announced that they have entered into an agreement concerning the resolution of this matter and have consented to the entry of this Final Order which sets forth the terms and conditions of the parties agreement.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- a. Respondent's Petition For Review be and is hereby denied.
- b. The Summary Order and Memorandum Decision and Initial Order Affirming Summary Order are amended to delete the conclusions that Respondent is guilty of unprofessional conduct as defined by rules and regulations of the Board at K.A.R. 60-3-110(a) "performing acts beyond the authorized scope of the level of nursing for which he was licensed"

and K.A.R. 60-3-110(c) "failing to take appropriate action or to follow policy and procedures in the practice situation to safeguard the patient". The Summary Order and the Memorandum Decision And Initial Order Affirming Summary Order are affirmed in all other respects.

c. Respondent shall not apply nor shall he be eligible to apply for reinstatement of his nursing license in the State of Kansas for 18 months after the effective date of this Order.

d. The effective date of this Order shall be the date on which executed copies are sent to Respondent and his counsel as reflected by the certificate of service.


