PROPOSED DEFAULT ORDER REVOKING LICENSE

NOW ON THIS 11th of August, 2004, petitioner appears by disciplinary counsel, Betty Wright, for a prehearing conference on the petition. Respondent does not appear.

Wherefore, the hearing officer finds as follows:

- 1. Respondent was licensed as a LPN. through 3/31/05. The board has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Petitioner sent a copy of the petition and notice of this hearing to respondent's last known address and service is proper.
- 3. Petitioner moves for issuance of a proposed default order revoking the respondent's license.
- 4. The petition is hereby granted and incorporated into this order as if set forth herein.

Respondent violated the Nurse Practice Act as alleged in the petition at:

K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(4), to be unable to practice with skill and safety due to current abuse of drugs or alcohol.

K.S.A. 65–1120(a)(6), unprofessional conduct by K.A.R. 60-3-110 (s) failing to complete the requirements of the impaired provider program of the board.

K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(2) to have been guilty of a felony or to have been guilty of a misdemeanor involving an illegal drug offense unless the applicant or licensee establishes sufficient rehabilitation to warrant the public trust.

- 6. Per petitioner's request, respondent's license to practice nursing is revoked. Respondent may not practice nursing in Kansas. Respondent is to mail the license card to the board immediately.
- 7. Respondent shall pay the costs of the action of \$70.
- 8. Disciplinary counsel shall mail a copy of this order to respondent's last known address.
