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ORDER

NOW, on this 16th day of June, 1983, the above-captioned case comes on for hearing. Petitioner appears by and through Timothy G. Madden, Assistant Attorney General. The respondent appears in person and through her counsel Charles Kent Pomeroy of Topeka. The petitioner and respondent present evidence and rest.

THEREUPON, THE BOARD, having heard the evidence and statements of counsel and witnesses, and being duly advised in the premises, finds as follows:

The respondent has violated the provisions of K.S.A. 1982 Supp. 65-1120(a) (6) as defined by K.A.R. 60-3-110(a) (4) and (a) (9) by diverting Demoral from and falsifying medical records at Stormont Vail Regional Medical Center, Topeka, Kansas, on or about January 2, 25, 29, February 8, 14 and 22, 1983 as related in the evidence produced at the hearing.

The Board Finds unanimously, with Joann Peavler abstaining from the proceedings, that the above acts constitute unprofessional conduct as provided by K.S.A. 65-1120(a) (6).

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED AND DECREED BY THE BOARD that respondent's license to practice professional nursing shall be limited for a period of two (2) years subject to the submission of quarterly reports by respondent's drug rehabilitation sponsor/counselor, and her nursing supervisor. Said reports shall inform the Board of respondent's drug rehabilitation progress and nursing performance and it shall be the responsibility of respondent to see that said reports are submitted

to the Board. The reports shall be sent to the Board of Nursing, Executive Administrator, 503 Kansas Avenue, Suite 330, P.O. Box 1098, Topeka, Kansas 66601.

The first report is due September 30, 1983 with subsequent reports due the last day of December, March, June and September until two years after the date of this hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that respondent's license be limited to the non-administration of narcotics for a period of two years from the date of this hearing.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
