

Findings of Fact

1. Respondent is or has been entitled to practice as a Licensed Practical Nurse, having been issued license no. 23-014575.

2. On or about November 14, 1986, Respondent was convicted of Forgery, a Class E felony in the Kansas District Court, Shawnee County, Kansas.

3. On or about January 17, 1990, Respondent was convicted of possessing an opiate or narcotic drug, a felony, in the Kansas District Court, Shawnee County, Kansas.

4. No evidence is presented to determine that Respondent is rehabilitated, as of this date.

Conclusions of Law

1. The Board may revoke, limit or suspend a nursing license if found to have been convicted of a felony and is not yet rehabilitated sufficiently to warrant the public trust.

2. A voluntary surrender of a license in a disciplinary proceeding results in the revocation of the license.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT the license of Leslie Johnson is revoked.


