FINAL ORDER

ON THE 8th day of July this matter came on for hearing before Terry E. Beck the Board's designated Hearing Officer on the Respondent's application for reinstatement. The Respondent appeared in person via telephone. The Kansas State Board of Nursing appeared by and through Assistant Attorney General Rex G. Beasley, Disciplinary Counsel for the Board.

THEREUPON the Respondent announced that she did not wish to pursue the application at this time; that she withdrew the application, and consented to the entry of an order denying the reinstatement application.

THEREUPON the Hearing officer made the following fact, and conclusions of law, and entered the following Final Order:

1. Respondent's withdrew her application for reinstatement.
2. Reinstatement of Respondent's license to practice nursing in the state of Kansas is denied.
3. This order does not decide the issues raised by the Petition filed by the Board in this matter or in the Respondent's application. This order will not operate as a bar or estoppel to the Respondent reapplying for a license at a later date nor to the Board's opposing such

reapplication based on any issues or defenses, including those which were or could have been raised in this matter.


