

ORDER

NOW ON this 12th day of March, 1996, comes on the Petitioner's Motion to Show Cause for non-compliance with probationary requirements established in the Consent Agreement and Final Order in Case No. 94-197-8. Petitioner Kansas State Board of Nursing appears by and through Special Assistant Attorney General Diane M. Glynn and Respondent appears in person. Respondent's last license to practice nursing lapsed on or about February 29, 1996 and Respondent submits at the time of this hearing a completed reinstatement application, appropriate fee of \$75.00 and a request for a 120 day temporary permit to complete continuing education requirements for this reinstatement and that which would have been required for this renewal period. After hearing statements of counsel and respondent this Hearing Officer makes the following findings:

1. That the Board has jurisdiction over this matter as Respondent voluntarily filed a reinstatement application with the Board.
2. That Respondent freely admits and has been non-compliant with the probationary term of the Consent Agreement and Final Order as follows:
 - a) Failure to complete 3 hours of CNE as previously ordered by not obtaining prior approval of courses and by completing only 2 hours of CNE on 9/5/95 when all were to be completed by 6/30/95.
 - b) Failure to notify the Board in writing or otherwise of any change in residence, home phone numbers, employment or other work situations within ten days of such changes.
 - c) Failure to cause to be submitted timely employer reports for the period ending 7/20/95, 10/20/95 and 1/20/96 as previously ordered.
3. That Respondent knowingly and willingly states his waiver of right to appeal this order so as to obtain a 120 day temporary permit to practice while completing CNE hours for renewal and as required and for completing other requirements set forth by this order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:


1. The show cause is granted as Respondent has been non-compliant with the Consent Agreement and Final Order.

2. Respondent is granted a 120 day permit to complete CNE requirements for this reinstatement and to obtain the remaining additional 1 hour CNE requirement on physical assessment as originally ordered.
3. Respondent shall cause employer reports to be submitted to the Board covering employment from 11/20/95 to 1/20/96, 1/21/96 to 4/20/96, and 4/20/96 to 6/1/96.
4. A review of this case and order shall be made as soon as Respondent completes the CNE or prior to June 30, 1996, whichever occurs first. At that review this hearing officer will consider granting the reinstatement of Respondent's license and any further conditions associated therewith.


