NOW ON THIS _____ day of January, 2008, petitioner, the Kansas State Board of Nursing, appears by disciplinary counsel, Alma A. Heckler, for a Hearing on the Petition.

Wherefore, the Presiding Officer finds as follows:

- 1. Respondent is licensed to practice nursing in Kansas through 8/31/2000. The Kansas State Board of Nursing has jurisdiction over the Respondent and the subject matter of this action.
- Petitioner sent a copy of the petition and notice of this hearing to respondent's last known address and service is proper.
- Petitioner moves for issuance of a proposed default order revoking respondent's license.
 The petitioner's request is granted by default.
- 4. The petition is hereby granted and incorporated into this order as if set forth herein.

 Respondent violated the Nurse Practice Act as alleged in the petition.
- 5. Per petitioner's request, respondent's license to practice nursing is revoked. Respondent may not practice nursing in Kansas. Respondent is to mail the license card to the Kansas State Board of Nursing office immediately.
- 6. Costs of the action of \$70 are assessed to respondent to be paid to the board by cash or money order within 30 days of the effective date of this order.
- 7. Respondent shall immediately forward his or her original Kansas licensed practical nurse license to the Kansas State Board of Nursing.

8. Disciplinary counsel shall mail a copy of this proposed default order to respondent's last known address.

PETITION

COMES NOW the petitioner, the Kansas State Board of Nursing, by and through
Assistant Attorney General assigned to the Board, Alma A. Heckler, and for its cause of action
states that:

- 1. Respondent is licensed to practice nursing in Kansas through 8/31/2008. The Board has jurisdiction over the respondent and the subject matter of this action.
- 2. For the purpose of service of this pleading, respondent's address of record is 1165 W Virginia Ln Apt 4, Olathe, KS 66061.
- 3. The Kansas State Board of Nursing has the authority under K.S.A. 74-1106 et seq. to examine, license and renew license for duly qualified applicants and may limit, deny, suspend or revoke a license or authorization to practice nursing, may issue a public or private censure and levy administrative fines consistent with K.S.A. 74-1110, if a violation of K.S.A. 65-1120(a) is established.

FACTS

4. The Respondent in this case requested a duplicate license. Respondent submitted a check drawn on Respondent's personal checking account dated 9/20/07 to pay the duplicate license fee of \$25.00. The check was returned by the financial institution for insufficient funds. The Respondent was notified of the returned insufficient funds check; by letter dated October 3, 2007 and a reminder phone call was made on 10/17/07 but a message was not left because the respondent does not have an answering machine and no one answered. To date there has been no money order received for payment of the duplicate license fee.

VIOLATIONS

5. Respondent has violated the Kansas Nurse Practice Act as follows:

Count 1: K.S.A.65-1120(a)(1), to be guilty of fraud or deceit in practicing nursing or in procuring or attempting to procure a license to practice nursing.

WHEREFORE, petitioner requests a finding that the respondent has violated the Nurse Practice Act, payment of the duplicate license fee of \$25.00, and returned check service fee of \$30.00, and revocation of respondent's license, and for respondent to be assessed the \$70.00 costs of this action. For a total amount assessed of \$125.00.
