DEFAULT ORDER to LIFT STAY of SUSPENSION OF LICENSE

Now on this 17th day of November, 2004 the petitioner's motion to lift the stay on respondent's license to practice nursing in the State of Kansas comes on for hearing. The respondent appears not. The petitioner, the board of nursing, by and through disciplinary counsel for the board, Betty Wright. The hearing officer makes the following findings and orders:

FINDINGS OF FACT


- 1. Respondent's address of record is 1940 Pottawatomie, Leavenworth, KS 66048. Proper service of the Petition and Notice of Hearing has been made. The Board has jurisdiction of the matter and of the Respondent.
- 2. The respondent is licensed as an LPN through 1/31/2006.
- 3. The Board's request to proceed under K.S.A. 77-536, is granted due to there being a situation involving an immediate danger to the public health, safety or welfare requiring immediate state agency action.
- 4. Petitioner moves for issuance of a proposed default order suspending license.
- 5. The petitioner's request is granted by default.
- 6. The petition is hereby granted and incorporated into this order as if set forth herein: respondent violated:

K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(6), unprofessional conduct by K.A.R. 60-3-110 (r) failing to comply with any disciplinary order of the board; and K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(6), unprofessional conduct by K.A.R. 60-3-110 (s) failing to complete the requirements of the impaired provider program of the board;

- 7. The hearing officer finds that the Stay of Suspension should be lifted and the license IS SUSPENDED and the respondent shall not practice as a nurse until further order of the Board.
- 8: The cost of this action \$70 are assessed to the licensee.

9. Disciplinary counsel shall mail a copy of this order to respondent's last known address.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
