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ORDER

NOW, on this 9th day of June, 1982, the above-captioned matter comes on for hearing. The Petitioner appears by and through its attorney, William M. Henry, Assistant Attorney General. The Respondent appears in person and by his attorney, Stan Basgall. The State and respondent each present evidence and rest.

THEREUPON, the Board, having heard the evidence and statements of counsel and being duly advised of the premises, FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

That the Respondent, as alleged in the petition, has violated the provisions of K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(6) having taken without authority dosages of Demerol from Russell City Hospital, which constitutes an act of unprofessional conduct.

IT IS THEREFORE, BY THE BOARD ORDERED AND DECREED that the Respondent's licenses to practice professional nursing and practical nursing shall be, and the same are hereby limited to practicing without giving narcotics through October 15, 1982. Respondent's licenses shall be issued to set out this limitation.
