ORDER

That respondent, as set forth in the Complaint, is mentally incompetent and that, pursuant to K.S.A. 1979 Supp. 65-1120(a)(5), respondent's license to practice practical nursing may be revoked, suspended or limited.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED AND DECREED, that respondent's license to practice practical nursing is hereby revoked, and respondent shall within ten (10) days from the day hereof surrender to the Board her license certificate.
