DEFAULT ORDER DENYING REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE

NOW ON THIS 5th day of March, 2003, petitioner appears by disciplinary counsel, Alma

A. Heckler, for a pre-hearing conference on the petition. Respondent does not appear.

1. Petitioner orally moves for issuance of a proposed default order denying respondent's application for reinstatement of her Licensed Mental Health Technician license.

Wherefore, the hearing officer finds as follows:

1. Petitioner's motion for a default order denying respondent's reinstatement application is hereby granted.
2. Respondent filed a reinstatement application on September 24, 2002.
3. Respondent violated K.S.A. 65-4209(a)(1), guilty of fraud or deceit in procuring or attempting to procure a license to practice mental health technology, due to her failure to report prior criminal convictions and the facts as set out in the petition are adopted and made a part of the findings in this order.
4. Petitioner sent a copy of the petition and notice of this hearing to respondent's last known address, addresses the respondent provided to the Board and service is proper. *Respondent failed to appear and is in default. TEB*
5. Costs of the action of \$70.00 are assessed to respondent to be paid to the Board by cash or money order within 30 days of the effective date of this order.

6. Disciplinary counsel shall mail a copy of this order to respondent's last known address.


