Pursuant to Virginia Code § 54.1-2409, you are hereby given notice that your license to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered December 19, 2017. You are hereby advised that you may not practice professional nursing or hold yourself out as a licensed professional nurse unless and until the Board of Nursing has notified you in writing that your license has been reinstated. Please return your license to Jay Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board"), at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

You may apply to the Board for reinstatement of your license, and you shall be entitled to a formal administrative hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of 60 days from the Board's receipt of your reinstatement application. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of the Board present at the hearing. ORDER OF MANDATORY SUSPENSION

In accordance with Virginia Code § 54.1-2409, I, Lisa R. Hahn, Chief Operating Officer, on behalf of

David E. Brown, D.C., Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and acted upon

evidence that the North Carolina Board of Nursing suspended the multistate licensure privilege of Rhonda Burks

Ragans, R.N., to practice as a registered nurse in the State of North Carolina. A certified copy of the

Settlement/Published Consent Order is attached hereto as Commonwealth's Exhibit 1.

WHEREUPON, by the authority vested in the Director of the Department of Health Professions pursuant

to Virginia Code § 54.1-2409, it is hereby ORDERED that the license of Rhonda Burks Ragans, R.N., to practice

professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia is hereby SUSPENDED.

Upon entry of this Order, the license of Rhonda Burks Ragans, R.N., will be recorded as suspended and

no longer current and valid. Should Ms. Ragans seek reinstatement of her license pursuant to Virginia Code §

54.1-2409, she shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement of the license prior to

issuance of the license to resume practice.

This Order shall be applicable to Ms. Ragans's multistate licensure privilege, if any, to practice

professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Pursuant to Virginia Code § 2.2-4023 and § 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in

the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public

inspection or copying on request.

This matter is before the North Carolina Board of Nursing ("Board") through the Settlement Committee by request of Rhonda Ragans, RN ("Licensee"). Licensee knowingly and voluntarily waives the right to a formal hearing under Art. 3A of N.C. Gen. Stat. §150B before the Board and the right to present evidence in her defense and in mitigation of any sanction that could be imposed for a violation, to confront and cross-examine witnesses and to challenge evidence presented by the Board against them, to present legal arguments in a brief, and to appeal from any final decision adverse to her license to practice nursing. Both parties stipulate and agree to the findings of fact and conclusions of law recited herein and to the Order imposed. By her consent, or challenge in any way the sufficiency of the findings of this Order. Licensee admits and the Board finds that:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- The North Carolina Board of Nursing is a body duly organized under the laws of North Carolina and is the proper body for this proceeding under the authority granted it in Article 9A, Chapter 90 of the General Statutes of North Carolina and the rules and regulations promulgated hereunder.
- 2. Licensee is the holder of Virginia Multistate Registered Nurse License Number 0001190884, which expires on November 30, 2017.
- 3. On November 28, 2016, the Board received a complaint regarding Licensee's nursing practice and began its investigation.
- 4. On November 4, 2016, while employed with Person Memorial Hospital in Roxboro, North Carolina, Licensee was reported to have slurred speech and improper interaction with patients and their family members. Licensee also exhibited erratic behavior when speaking with nursing staff.
- 5. Licensee was asked to submit to a for-cause drug screen, but was unable to void for the urine drug screen. Licensee then attempted to self-insert a catheter, but was subsequently taken to the Emergency Department and catheterized by staff.
- 6. Licensee's drug screen returned positive for benzodiazepines, for which she did not have a valid prescription.
- 7. On February 16, 2017 during an interview with Board staff, Licensee acknowledged taking Ativan and Valium on November 3, 2016 that belonged to her friend.

8. On July 13, 2017, Licensee appeared before the Settlement Committee, consisting of Board Members Sharon Moore, RN and Bob Newsom, LPN to hold a settlement conference with regard to the above-referenced matter. Licensee was represented in this matter by her attorney, Robert Crawford, III.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. This matter is properly before the Board, and the Board has jurisdiction over Licensee and the subject matter of this case.
- 2. Licensee's conduct, as set out in the Findings of Fact above, constitutes grounds for discipline pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. §90-171.37 as follows:
 - has a mental or physical disability or uses any drug to a degree that interferes with his or her fitness to practice nursing;
 - (4) engages in conduct that endangers the public health;

(7) has violated any provision of this Article;

(8) has willfully violated any rules enacted by the Board;

and Rule 21 N.C. Admin. Code 36 .0217(c)

(1) drug or alcohol abuse;

- (2) illegally obtaining, possessing or distributing drugs or alcohol for personal or other use, or other violations of N.C. Gen. Stat. §90-86 to §90-113.8; and
- (21) accepting responsibility for client care while impaired by alcohol or other pharmacological agents.
- 3. Grounds exist pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. §90-171.37 for the Board to revoke or suspend the privilege to practice and invoke other such disciplinary measures such as censure or probative terms against a licensee as it deems fit and proper.

ORDER

- 1. Based on the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, without further notice of proceedings, the Board enters into the following Order with Licensee.
- 2. Licensee's privilege to practice shall be suspended for a minimum of six (6) months.

- 3. In accordance with N.C. Gen. Stat. §90-171.27(d) and Board of Nursing policy derived therefrom, a fee of \$300.00 will be assessed. The fee will be due prior to scheduling an appearance before the Licensure Review Panel ("LRP").
- 4. The Board will not recommend to the Division of Health Services Regulation that Licensee be eligible to request listing as a Nurse Aide I or Medication Aide.
 - Licensee may not be listed on the Nurse Aide II Registry.
- 6. At such time as Licensee is permitted to petition for reinstatement of the privilege to practice, Licensee may request an appearance before the LRP and shall comply with all decisions of the LRP.
- 7. This Order is a public record, as required by N.C. Gen. Stat. §132, and will be placed in Licensee's file. All disciplinary actions taken by the Board will be reported to the appropriate entities as outlined in Board policy and as required by state and/or federal guidelines. Those entities include, but may not be limited to, NURSYS, National Practitioner Data Bank (NPDB), the Office of the Inspector General (OIG) and any other jurisdiction in which Licensee is or has been licensed.
- 8. This Order shall take effect immediately upon proper execution by both Licensee and the Board.
