CONSENT ORDER

JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Mark Anthony LaQuihon, as evidenced by their signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to an informal conference, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Mr. LaQuihon's application for licensure by endorsement to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Mark Anthony LaQuihon submitted an application for license by endorsement to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia on June 24, 2017. His Primary state of residence is Wyoming.
2. Mr. LaQuihon was issued License Number RN 20666 by the Wyoming Board of Nursing on November 29, 2016. Said license is scheduled to expire on December 31, 2018.
3. Mr. LaQuihon violated Virginia Code § 54.1-3007(1) and 18 VAC 90-19-230(A)(1)(b) of the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing in that on his application for licensure by endorsement to practice professional nursing received by the Board on June 24, 2017, Mr. LaQuihon answered "NO" to the question "Have you ever been convicted, pled guilty to or pled Nolo Contendere to the violation of any federal, state or other statute constituting a felony or misdemeanor?" when, in fact, on January 7, 1998, he pled guilty of driving while intoxicated in the Park County, Wyoming, Circuit Court.
3. Mr. LaQuihon otherwise meets the requirements of Virginia Code § 54.1-3017.

CONSENT

Mark Anthony LaQuihon, by affixing his signature to this Consent Order, agrees to the following:

1. I have been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia Code § 2.2-4000 *et seq.*;
3. I acknowledge that I have the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Board; and the right to representation by counsel;
4. I waive my right to an informal conference;
5. I admit to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waive my right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any sanction imposed hereunder in any future judicial or administrative proceeding in which the Board is a party;
6. I consent to the entry of the following Order affecting my application for licensure by endorsement to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Board of Nursing hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. Mark Anthony LaQuihon is REPRIMANDED.
2. The application of Mark Anthony LaQuihon for licensure to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia is APPROVED. Mr. LaQuihon shall be issued a license to practice professional nursing that is valid in Virginia only.
3. Mr. LaQuihon shall comply with all laws and regulations governing the practice of nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.
