#### **CONSENT ORDER**

## JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Casey Lynn Brewster, as evidenced by their signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to an informal conference, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Brewster's application for licensure by examination to practice massage therapy in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

## FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Casey Lynn Brewster submitted an application for licensure by examination to practice massage therapy in the Commonwealth of Virginia on February 25, 2017.
- 2. Ms. Brewster violated Virginia Code § 54.1-3007(1) and 18 VAC 90-50-90(1)(b) of the Regulations Governing the Licensure of Massage Therapists in that on her application for licensure by examination to practice massage therapy received by the Board on February 28, 2017, Ms. Brewster answered "NO" to the question "Have you ever been convicted, pled guilty to or pled Nolo Contendere to the violation of any federal, state or other statute or ordinance constituting a felony or misdemeanor?" when, in fact, on July 10, 2009, she was convicted of possession of paraphernalia, a misdemeanor, in the Prince William County, Virginia, General District Court.
  - 3. Ms. Brewster otherwise meets the requirements of Virginia Code § 54.1-3029.

### CONSENT

Casey Lynn Brewster, by affixing her signature to this Consent Order, agrees to the following:

1. I have been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;

- 2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia Code § 2.2-4000 et seq.;
- 3. I acknowledge that I have the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Board; and the right to representation by counsel;
  - 4. I waive my right to an informal conference;
- 5. I admit to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waive my right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any sanction imposed hereunder in any future judicial or administrative proceeding in which the Board is a party;
- 6. I consent to the entry of the following Order affecting my application for licensure by examination to practice massage therapy in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

#### **ORDER**

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Board of Nursing hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. Casey Lynn Brewster is REPRIMANDED.
- 2. The application of Casey Lynn Brewster for licensure to practice massage therapy in the Commonwealth of Virginia is APPROVED and she shall be issued an unrestricted license to practice massage therapy in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- 3. Ms. Brewster shall comply with all laws and regulations governing the practice of massage therapy in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.
