ORDER OF MANDATORY SUSPENSION


In accordance with Virginia Code § 54.1-2409, I, David E. Brown, D.C., Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and acted upon evidence that Susan Denise Seymour Franklin, L.P.N., was convicted of six felony offenses, to wit: three counts of check forgery and three counts of utter a forged check, in the Circuit Court of Henrico County, Virginia. WHEREUPON, by the authority vested in the Director of the Department of Health Professions pursuant to Virginia Code § 54.1-2409, it is hereby ORDERED that the license of Susan Denise Seymour Franklin, L.P.N., to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia is hereby SUSPENDED.

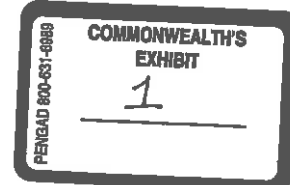

On May 22, 2012, came the defendant, who was led to the bar in the custody of the Sheriff of this Court, and came also Richard Fuller, her attorney heretofore appointed. The Commonwealth was represented by Kristin Knudsen.

On January 24, 2012, the defendant was found guilty of the following offense(s):

The pre-sentence report was considered and is ordered filed as a part of the record in these cases in accordance with the provisions of Code Section 19.2-299.

Pursuant to the provisions of Code Section 19.2-298.01, the Court has considered and reviewed the applicable discretionary sentencing guidelines and the guidelines worksheet. The sentencing guidelines worksheet and the written explanation of any departure from the guidelines are ordered filed as a part of the record in these cases.

And it being demanded of the defendant if anything for herself she had or knew to say why judgment should not be pronounced against her according to law, and nothing being offered or alleged in delay of judgment, the Court sentences the defendant in Case No. CR11-4467-00F, to incarceration with the Virginia Department of Corrections for the term of five (5) years, the execution of four (4) years of which sentence is suspended for ten (10) years, and in Case No. CR11-4470-00F, to three (3) years, the execution of two (2) years of which sentence is suspended for ten (10) years. In Case Nos. CR11-4468, 4472-00F, the defendant is sentenced to incarceration with the Virginia Department of Correction, for the term of three (3) years, in each case, the execution of which sentence is suspended for ten (10) years, in each case, and in Case Nos. CR11-4469, 4471-00F, to five (5) years in each case, the execution of which sentence is suspended for ten (10) years. Conditions of her suspended sentence are that she keep the peace and be of good behavior, that upon her release from incarceration she be placed on probation

under the supervision of a District #32 Probation Officer of this Court, and that she pays restitution in the amount of \$1,865.54 to James Clark Franklin, Jr., said restitution to be monitored by the Henrico County Community Corrections Program. The Court further Orders that the defendant pay the costs of these cases in the amount of 5,095.00.

By operation of law, the defendant's privilege to operate a motor vehicle shall be suspended by the Department of Motor Vehicles effective fifteen days from this date if the costs are not paid pursuant to Virginia Code Section 46.2-395.

The defendant shall be given credit for time spent in confinement while awaiting trial pursuant to Virginia Code Section 53.1-187.

The Court certifies that at all times during this proceeding the defendant was present in person and her attorney was likewise present in person and capably represented the defendant for which services he is allowed an attorney's fee in the amount of \$2,670.00.

Thereupon, the defendant was remanded to the custody of the Sheriff.
