CONSENT ORDER

JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Bailey Renee Martin, as evidenced by their signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to an informal conference, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Martin's application for certification by endorsement to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Bailey Renee Martin, C.N.A. submitted an application for certificate by endorsement to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia on April 29, 2017.
2. Ms. Martin was issued a certificate to practice as a nurse aide by the North Carolina Board of Nursing.
3. Ms. Martin violated Virginia Code § 54.1-3007(4) in that on March 13, 2017, she pled guilty to and was convicted of petit larceny, a crime of moral turpitude, in the Circuit Court of the City of Roanoke, Virginia.
4. Ms. Martin otherwise meets the requirements of Virginia Code § 54.1-3024.

CONSENT

Bailey Renee Martin, C.N.A., by affixing her signature to this Consent Order, agrees to the following:

1. I have been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;

2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia Code § 2.2-4000 *et seq.*;
3. I acknowledge that I have the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Board; and the right to representation by counsel;
4. I waive my right to an informal conference;
5. I admit to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waive my right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any sanction imposed hereunder in any future judicial or administrative proceeding in which the Board is a party;
6. I consent to the entry of the following Order affecting my application for certification by endorsement to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Board of Nursing hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. Bailey Renee Martin, C.N.A., is REPRIMANDED.
2. The application of Bailey Renee Martin, C.N.A., for certification to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia is APPROVED. Ms. Martin shall be issued an unrestricted certificate to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
3. Ms. Martin shall comply with all laws and regulations governing the practice of certified nurse aides in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

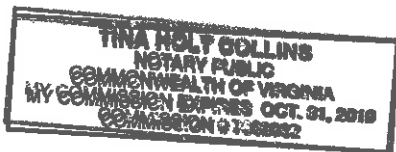
