CONSENT ORDER

JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Virginia Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and Medicine ("Committee of the Joint Boards") and Donna Marie Hugate Greenfield, L.N.P., as evidenced by their signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to an informal conference, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Greenfield's license to practice as a nurse practitioner, in the category of certified nurse midwife, in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Donna Marie Hugate Greenfield, L.N.P., was issued License Number 0024-166424 to practice as a nurse practitioner, in the category of certified nurse midwife, on September 26, 2006, which is scheduled to expire on January 31, 2019. Ms. Greenfield was issued Prescriptive Authority Number 0017-138687 on September 20, 2006, which is scheduled to expire on January 31, 2019. Ms. Greenfield was issued License Number 0001-122482 to practice professional nursing on March 18, 1991, which is scheduled to expire on January 31, 2019.
2. Ms. Greenfield violated Virginia Code § § 54.1-2957(B) and 54.1-2957.01(A) and (B) in that during the course of her employment with Gentiva Hospice, Williamsburg, Virginia, in May of 2016, Ms. Greenfield ordered an emergency prescription for morphine, a Schedule II controlled substance, without previously engaging in a written practice agreement with a collaborating team physician.

CONSENT

Donna Marie Hugate Greenfield, L.N.P., by affixing her signature to this Consent Order, agrees to the following:

1. I have been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me or my license except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia Code § 2.2-4000 *et seq.*;
3. I acknowledge that I have the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Committee of the Joint Boards; and the right to representation by counsel;
4. I waive my right to an informal conference;
5. I admit to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waive my right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any sanction imposed hereunder in any future judicial or administrative proceeding in which the Committee of the Joint Boards is a party;
6. I consent to the entry of the following Order affecting my licensure to practice as a nurse practitioner, in the category of certified nurse midwife, in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and Medicine hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. Within 60 days of the entry of this Order, Donna Marie Hugate Greenfield, L.N.P. will provide a copy of her current practice agreement to the Board of Nursing.
2. Donna Marie Hugate Greenfield, L.N.P., will review the following guidance and regulations governing nurse practitioners:

- a. Guidance Document 90-56, Practice Agreement Requirements for Licensed Nurse Practitioners.
- b. Regulations Governing the Licensure of Nurse Practitioners, 18 VAC 90-30-10 *et. seq.*
- c. Regulations Governing Prescriptive Authority for Nurse Practitioners, 18 VAC 90-40-10 *et. seq.*


Within 60 days of the entry of this Order, Donna Marie Hugate Greenfield, L.N.P., will submit to the Board a written statement that explains her current understanding of the guidance and regulations mentioned above.

3. Donna Marie Hugate Greenfield, L.N.P., shall comply with all laws and regulations governing the practice of nurse practitioners in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

4. Any violation of the foregoing terms and conditions of this Order or any statute or regulation governing the practice of nurse practitioners shall constitute grounds for further disciplinary action.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

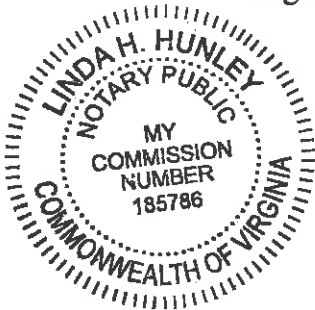
