CONSENT ORDER

JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Jenness Myler, L.P.N., as evidenced by their signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to an informal conference, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Myler's application for licensure by endorsement to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Jenness Myler, L.P.N., submitted an application for license by endorsement to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia on July 11, 2017. Her primary state of residence is Virginia.
2. Ms. Myler was issued License Number VN174379 by the California Board of Nursing in 1995 which is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2019.
3. Ms. Myler violated Virginia Code § 54.1-3007(4) in that on November 29, 1988, she pled guilty to and was convicted of grand theft of property, a crime of moral turpitude, in the Municipal Court of California, County of San Diego.
4. Ms. Myler violated Virginia Code § 54.1-3007(1) and 18 VAC 90-19-230(A)(1)(b) of the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing in that on her application for licensure by endorsement received by the Board on July 11, 2017, Ms. Myler answered "NO" to the question "Have you ever been convicted, pled guilty to or pled Nolo Contendere to the violation of any federal, state or other statute

constituting a felony or misdemeanor?" when, in fact, she was convicted of grand theft as evidenced above.

3. Ms. Myler otherwise meets the requirements of Virginia Code § 54.1-3021.

CONSENT

Jenness Myler, L.P.N., by affixing her signature to this Consent Order, agrees to the following:

1. I have been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia Code § 2.2-4000 *et seq.*;
3. I acknowledge that I have the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Board; and the right to representation by counsel;
4. I waive my right to an informal conference;
5. I admit to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waive my right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any sanction imposed hereunder in any future judicial or administrative proceeding in which the Board is a party;
6. I consent to the entry of the following Order affecting my application for licensure by endorsement to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

ORDER


Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Board of Nursing hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. Jenness Myler, L.P.N., is REPRIMANDED.
2. The application of Jenness Myler, L.P.N., for licensure to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia is APPROVED. Ms. Myler shall be issued an unrestricted license to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

3. Ms. Myler shall comply with all laws and regulations governing the practice of nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.



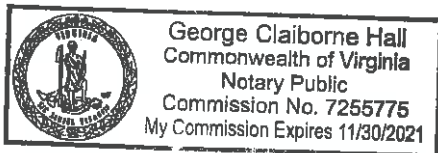


