CONSENT ORDER

JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Taylor Wright, C.N.A., as evidenced by their signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to an informal conference, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Wright's certificate to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Taylor Wright, C.N.A., was issued Certificate Number 1401-178402 to practice as a nurse aide on February 24, 2016, which is scheduled to expire on February 28, 2018.
2. Ms. Wright violated Virginia Code § 54.1-3007(1) and 18 VAC 90-25-100(1)(b) of the Regulations Governing Certified Nurse Aides in that on her application for certification to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia, dated December 3, 2013, she falsely answered "no" to the question asking whether she had ever been convicted of, pled guilty to, or pled no contest to the violation of any federal, state or other law constituting a felony or a misdemeanor when, in fact, she had been convicted of misdemeanor possession of marijuana on March 27, 2013, in the General District Court of Roanoke County, Virginia.

CONSENT

Taylor Wright, C.N.A., by affixing her signature to this Consent Order, agrees to the following:

1. I have been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me or my certificate except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia Code § 2.2-4000 *et seq.*;

3. I acknowledge that I have the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Board; and the right to representation by counsel;
4. I waive my right to an informal conference;
5. I admit to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waive my right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any sanction imposed hereunder in any future judicial or administrative proceeding in which the Board is a party;
6. I consent to the entry of the following Order affecting my certification to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.


ORDER


Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Board of Nursing hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. Taylor Wright, C.N.A., is REPRIMANDED.
2. Ms. Wright shall comply with all laws and regulations governing the practice of certified nurse aides in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.
