ORDER OF MANDATORY SUSPENSION

In accordance with Virginia Code § 54.1-2409, I, David E. Brown, D.C., Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and acted upon evidence that Stephanie Lynn Workman, R.M.A., was convicted of a felony offense, to wit: involuntary manslaughter, in the Circuit Court of Alleghany County, Virginia. A certified copy of the Conviction and Sentencing Order is attached hereto as Commonwealth's Exhibit 1.

WHEREUPON, by the authority vested in the Director of the Department of Health Professions pursuant to Virginia Code § 54.1-2409, it is hereby ORDERED that the right of Stephanie Lynn Workman, R.M.A., to renew her registration to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia is hereby SUSPENDED.

Upon entry of this Order, the registration of Stephanie Lynn Workman, R.M.A., will be recorded as. Should Ms. Workman seek reinstatement of her registration pursuant to Virginia Code § 54.1-2409, she shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement of the registration prior to issuance of the registration to resume practice.

Pursuant to Virginia Code § 2.2-4023 and § 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying on request.

COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA

STEPHANIE WORKMAN, Defendant

This day came the defendant, Stephanie Workman, who appeared in person and with her attorney, Scott Webber, for trial. The Commonwealth was represented by Edward K. Stein.

Whereupon the defendant was arraigned as charged in the indictment, and after being advised by her counsel pleaded no contest to the indictment, which plea was tendered by the defendant in person, and the Court, having made inquiry and being of the opinion that the defendant fully understood the nature and effect of her plea and of the penalties that may be imposed upon her conviction, and of the waiver of trial by jury and of appeal, proceeded to try this case without the intervention of a jury as provided by law.

And the Court having been advised by the defendant, her counsel, the Attorney for the Commonwealth that there has been a plea agreement in this case, and the Court finds that the Commonwealth has complied with the provision of VA. Code Section 19.2-11.01(A)(4)(d) and such agreement in writing having been presented to the Court, and now filed herein, and having heard the stipulated evidence of the Attorney for the Commonwealth, upon concurrence of the defendant and her counsel, the Court hereby finds the defendant guilty of the following offense:

Pursuant to the provisions of VA. Code Section 19.2-298.01, the Court has considered and reviewed the applicable discretionary sentencing guidelines and the guidelines worksheets. The sentencing guidelines worksheets and the written explanation of any departure from the guidelines are ordered filed as a part of the record in these cases, without objection of counsel for the defendant.

Before pronouncing the sentence, the Court inquired if the defendant desired to make a statement and if the defendant desired to advance any reason why judgment should not be pronounced.

The Court **SENTENCES** the defendant in accordance with the plea agreement to:

Incarceration with the **Virginia Department of Corrections** for the term of: **five (5) years for this case.**

The Court **SUSPENDS** the execution of the aforesaid penitentiary sentence in its **entirety** upon the following conditions:

Good behavior. The defendant shall be of good behavior, obey the law and not use or possess any illegal substances for a period of five (5) years.

Supervised probation. The defendant is placed on probation to commence immediately under the supervision of a probation officer for a period of two (2) years. The defendant shall comply with all the rules and requirements set by the probation officer. Probation shall include substance abuse counseling and/or testing as prescribed by the probation officer.

DNA. And it is further ORDERED that the defendant shall submit a sample of her DNA that shall be taken for analysis in accordance with the procedures set forth in Article 1.1 of Chapter 18 or Title 19.2 of the Code of Virginia. The defendant submitted DNA on 10/16/2017.

Costs. The defendant shall pay court costs totaling \$453.00 to be paid in monthly installments of \$50.00 beginning 11/16/2017 and every month thereafter until paid in full. Failure to receive payment as ordered shall result in the suspension of the defendant's operator's license pursuant to VA. Code Section 46.2-395.

The defendant was advised in open court of the right to appeal, the right of indigents to have court appointed counsel and to have a copy of the transcript prepared on appeal.

The Court certifies the defendant was personally present with her attorney, Mr. Webber. The Court further certifies the Clerk was present and did record and take down the evidence in this case.
