CONSENT ORDER

JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Virginia Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and Medicine ("Committee of the Joint Boards") and Mary Josephine Endahl, L.N.P., as evidenced by their signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to an informal conference, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Endahl's license to practice as a nurse practitioner in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Mary Josephine Endahl, L.N.P., was issued License Number 0024-173448 to practice as a nurse practitioner in the category of certified nurse midwife on April 29, 2016, which is scheduled to expire on October 31, 2018. Ms. Endahl was also issued License Number 0001-270027 to practice professional nursing on January 26, 2017, which is scheduled to expire on October 31, 2018. Her primary state of residence is Washington.

2. When she first obtained her Virginia nurse practitioner license, Ms. Endahl resided in Tennessee and held a license to practice professional nursing in Tennessee, which conferred on her a multistate licensure privilege to practice professional nursing in Virginia. Ms. Endahl's Tennessee nursing license expired on October 31, 2016. Because she had relocated to Virginia, the Tennessee Board of Nursing did not renew her Tennessee license. Ms. Endahl did not apply for licensure to practice professional nursing in Virginia until January 23, 2017.

3. Ms. Endahl violated Virginia Code § 54.1-3007(3) and 18 VAC 90-30-60(B) and 18 VAC 90-30-80(A)(1) of the Regulations Governing the Licensure of Nurse Practitioners in that during the course of her employment with Carilion Clinic, New River Valley Obstetrics and Gynecology, Roanoke, Virginia, between November 1, 2016, and January 23, 2017, Ms. Endahl practiced as a nurse practitioner without a current Virginia nursing license or a multistate licensure privilege.

4. Ms. Endahl's employment with Carilion Clinic was suspended for three days. There was no harm to patients noted due to Ms. Endahl's unlicensed practice.

CONSENT

Mary Josephine Endahl, L.N.P., by affixing her signature to this Consent Order, agrees to the following:

1. I have been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me or my license except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia Code § 2.2-4000 *et seq.*;
3. I acknowledge that I have the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Committee of the Joint Boards; and the right to representation by counsel;
4. I waive my right to an informal conference;
5. I admit to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waive my right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any sanction imposed hereunder in any future judicial or administrative proceeding in which the Committee of the Joint Boards is a party;
6. I consent to the entry of the following Order affecting my licensure to practice as a nurse practitioner in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and Medicine hereby ORDERS as follows:


1. Mary Josephine Endahl, L.N.P., is assessed a MONETARY PENALTY of \$ 500.00. This penalty shall be paid to the Board of Nursing by certified check or money order made payable to the Treasurer of Virginia within 90 days from the date of entry of this Order. Failure to pay the full monetary penalty by the due date may cause the matter to be sent for collection and constitutes grounds for an administrative proceeding and further discipline.

2. Ms. Endahl shall comply with all laws and regulations governing the practice of nurse practitioners in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

3. Any violation of the foregoing terms and conditions of this Order or any statute or regulation governing the practice of nurse practitioners shall constitute grounds for further disciplinary action.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.
