Dear Ms. Beavers:

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered July 1, 2010. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your license to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your license, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

Should you wish to petition the Board of Nursing for reinstatement of your license, contact Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director, at the above address or (804) 367-4599.

ORDER

In accordance with Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), I, Dianne L. Reynolds-Cane, M.D., Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and acted upon evidence that Jennifer Ann Beavers, L.P.N., was convicted of a felony charge in the Circuit Court for the County of Washington, Virginia, to wit: One (1) Count of Credit Card Forgery. A certified copy of the Conviction and Sentencing Order is attached to this Order and is marked as Commonwealth's Exhibit No. 1.

WHEREFORE, by the authority vested in the Director of the Department of Health Professions pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, it is hereby ORDERED that the license of Jennifer Ann Beavers, L.P.N., to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia be, and hereby is, suspended.

Upon entry of this Order, the license of Jennifer Ann Beavers, L.P.N., will be recorded as suspended and no longer current. Should Ms. Beavers seek reinstatement of her license pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, she shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement and renewal of her license prior to issuance of her license to resume practice.

Pursuant to Sections 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

Following the avowal of the evidence by the Commonwealth and the stipulation to such by the defendant, the Court found the evidence sufficient to support a finding of guilt

All suspensions or deferrals are conditioned upon defendant's general good behavior and, in the case of supervised probation, upon compliance with all terms and conditions of probation as adopted by this court. Probation shall include substance abuse counseling and/or testing as prescribed by the Probation Officer.

PROBATION Supervised 2 Years Commencing This date

Defendant Ordered to complete any substance abuse screening, assessment, testing and treatment as directed by the Department of Corrections. The defendant shall be subject payment of any fees associated with substance abuse treatment or intervention.

Defendant directed to submit a blood sample for DNA analysis this date

Special Program. As a special condition of probation, the defendant shall pick up trash and litter in a designated area of Washington County as assigned by his/her Probation Officer and/or the Litter Control Officer.

Restitution: Amount: \$ 78.00 payable to David Wayne Heath

Court-appointed fee: Court-appointed counsel shall receive a fee in the sum of \$ TBD for his/her services.

Payment of Costs/Fine/Restitution:


\$50.00 Due monthly commencing within 30 days of this date.


