CONSENT ORDER

JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and McKenzi Ann Darby Marie Sweetser, as evidenced by their signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to an informal conference, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Sweetser's application for registration by examination to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. McKenzi Ann Darby Marie Sweetser submitted an application for registration by examination to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia on March 31, 2017.
2. Ms. Sweetser violated Virginia Code § 54.1-3007(4) in that on April 9, 2014, she was convicted of shoplifting, a misdemeanor of moral turpitude, in the Winchester, Virginia, General District Court. On November 6, 2015, Ms. Sweetser was convicted of petit larceny, a misdemeanor of moral turpitude, in the Winchester, Virginia, Circuit Court.
3. Ms. Sweetser otherwise meets the requirements of Virginia Code § 54.1-3042.

CONSENT

McKenzi Ann Darby Marie Sweetser, R.M.A., by affixing her signature to this Consent Order, agrees to the following:

1. I have been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia Code § 2.2-4000 *et seq.*;

3. I acknowledge that I have the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Board; and the right to representation by counsel;

4. I waive my right to an informal conference;

5. I admit to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waive my right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any sanction imposed hereunder in any future judicial or administrative proceeding in which the Board is a party;

6. I consent to the entry of the following Order affecting my application for registration by examination to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Board of Nursing hereby ORDERS as follows:


1. McKenzie Ann Darby Marie Sweetser is REPRIMANDED.

2. The application of Ms. Sweetser for registration to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia is APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the medication aide examination, Ms. Sweetser shall be issued an unrestricted registration to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth.

3. Ms. Sweetser shall comply with all laws and regulations governing the practice of medication aides in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.


