Dear Ms. Rollins:

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that the privilege to renew your license to practice as a professional nurse in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered March 16, 2016. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your license to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your license, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

Should you wish to petition the Board of Nursing for reinstatement of your license, the application may be obtained at www.dhp.virginia.gov.

In accordance with Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), I, David E. Brown, D.C., Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and acted upon evidence that Melinda Lauraine Byrd Rollins, R.N., was found guilty of one (1) felony charge in the Circuit Court of Fauquier County, Virginia, to wit: One (1) Count of Hit & Run w/ Injury- Fail Report. A certified copy of the Sentencing Order is attached and is marked as Commonwealth's Exhibit No. 1.

WHEREFORE, by the authority vested in the Director of the Department of Health Professions pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, it is hereby ORDERED that the privilege of Melinda Lauraine Byrd Rollins, R.N., to renew her license to practice as a professional nurse in the Commonwealth of Virginia be, and hereby is, SUSPENDED.

Upon entry of this Order, the license of Melinda Lauraine Byrd Rollins, R.N., will be recorded as suspended and no longer current. Should Ms. Rollins seek reinstatement of her license pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, she shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement and renewal of her license prior to issuance of her license to resume practice.



(3) THE COURT COSTS ARE \$803.00 WHICH AMOUNT INCLUDES AN ALLOWANCE OF \$200.00 FOR COURT-APPOINTED COUNSEL.

The defendant was remanded to the custody of the sheriff. The defendant was allowed to depart.

The defendant shall be given credit for time spent in confinement while awaiting trial pursuant to Virginia Code § 53.1-187.
