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**CONSENT ORDER**

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**JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY**

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Nyesha Alexandria Brown Jenkins, L.P.N., as evidenced by their signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to an informal conference, enter into the following Consent Order affecting the license of Ms. Jenkins to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

**FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. Nyesha Alexandria Brown Jenkins, L.P.N., was issued License Number 0002-085464 to practice practical nursing on August 12, 2011, which is scheduled to expire on October 31, 2019. Her primary state of residence is Virginia.
2. Ms. Jenkins violated Virginia Code § 54.1-3007(2), (5) and (8) and 18 VAC 90-20-300(A)(2)(e) and (f) of the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing (currently found at 18 VAC 90-19-230(A)(2)(e) and (f), effective February 24, 2017) in that during the course of her employment with Heart Song Care, Newport News, Virginia, for Humana at Home Care, between October 2014 and January 2015, Ms. Jenkins documented face-to-face visits with home health patients that did not occur.
  - (a) Ms. Jenkins reported that she visited Patient A a total of four times in January of 2014. Patient A's care-giver reported to the Humana investigator that these visits did not occur.
  - (b) Ms. Jenkins reported that she visited Patient B a total of four times in January of 2015. Patient B reported to the Humana investigator that these visits did not occur.

(c) Ms. Jenkins reported that she visited Patient C a total of twelve times from November 2014-January 2015. Patient C's at-home care manager reported to the Humana investigator that these visits did not occur.

(d) Ms. Jenkins reported that she visited Patient D a total of twelve times from November 2014 – January 2015. Patient D's at-home care manager reported to the Humana investigator that these visits did not occur.

(e) Ms. Jenkins reported that she visited Patient E a total of twelve times from November 2014 – January 2015. Patient E's family member reported to the Humana investigator that these visits did not occur.

(f) Ms. Jenkins reported that she visited Patient F a total of fourteen times from October 2014 to January 2015; however, Patient F reported to the Humana investigator that these visits did not occur.

3. Ms. Jenkins resigned from Heart Song Care prior to termination.
4. Ms. Jenkins failed to cooperate with the Department of Health Professions' investigation in this matter.

### CONSENT

Nyesha Alexandria Brown Jenkins, L.P.N., by affixing her signature to this Consent Order, agrees to the following:

1. I have been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me or my license except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia Code § 2.2-4000 *et seq.*;

3. I acknowledge that I have the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Board; the right to representation by counsel; and the right to cross-examine witnesses against me;

4. I waive my right to an informal conference;

5. I admit to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waive my right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any sanction imposed hereunder in any future judicial or administrative proceeding in which the Board is a party;

6. I consent to the entry of the following Order affecting my licensure to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.


### ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Board of Nursing hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. Nyesha Alexandria Brown Jenkins, L.P.N., is REPRIMANDED.
2. Nyesha Alexandria Brown Jenkins, L.P.N., shall comply with all laws and regulations governing the practice of practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.



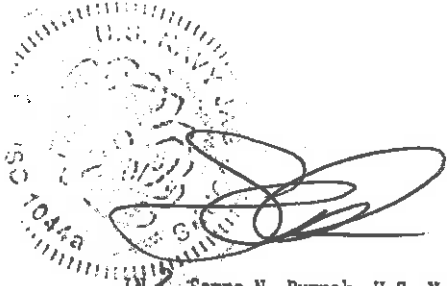
