Dear Ms. Stover:

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered April 6, 2015. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your license to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your license, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

**ORDER**

In accordance with Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), I, David E. Brown, D.C., Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and acted upon evidence that Ashleigh Anne Stover, L.P.N., pled guilty to, and was found to be guilty of felony charges in the Circuit Court for the City of Newport News, Virginia, to wit:

1. One (1) Count of Grand Larceny; and
2. One (1) Count of Larceny With Intent to Sell.

A Certified copy of the Court Order is attached to this Order and is marked as Commonwealth's Exhibit No. 1.

WHEREFORE, by the authority vested in the Director of the Department of Health Professions pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, it is hereby ORDERED that the license of Ashleigh Anne Stover, L.P.N., to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia be, and hereby is, suspended.

Upon entry of this Order, the license of Ashleigh Anne Stover, L.P.N., will be recorded as suspended and no longer current. Should Ms. Stover seek reinstatement of her license pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, she shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement and renewal of her license prior to issuance of her license to resume practice.

Pursuant to Sections 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

This day came the defendant, who appeared according to the condition of her recognizance and was represented by attorney Barbara Rosenblatt, heretofore appointed. Brock Maust, the attorney for the Commonwealth was also present. Robin Stewart, Court appointed Court Reporter, was sworn to faithfully and accurately take down and transcribe the proceedings herein. The defendant is indicted on the following offenses:

Whereupon the defendant waived formal arraignment, and after private consultation with and being advised by her counsel, pleaded **GUILTY** to the indictments, which plea was tendered by the defendant in person, and the Court having made inquiry and being of the opinion that the defendant fully understood the nature and effect of her plea and of the penalties that may be imposed upon her convictions, and after having been first advised by her attorney and by the Court of her right to trial by jury, the defendant knowingly and voluntarily waived trial by jury and with the concurrence of the attorney for the Commonwealth and of the Court, here entered of record, the Court proceeded to hear and determine these cases without the intervention of a jury, as provided by law.

The attorney for the Commonwealth having summarized the evidence with the consent of the defendant by counsel, and all argument of counsel being heard, the Court finds the defendant **GUILTY** as charged in said indictments, to wit:

Grand Larceny (Va. Code §18.2-95)

CR15000630-00

Larceny with Intent to Sell (Va. Code §18.2-108.01)

The Court on motion of the defendant, by counsel, before fixing punishment or imposing sentence, directs the Probation Officer of this Court to thoroughly investigate the history of the defendant and report all relevant facts to the Court as provided by law and sentencing is set for **June 19, 2015 at 9:00 AM**, before Judge Bryant L. Sugg in Circuit Court #4, to which time these cases are continued.

The record made by the Court Reporter herein of the said proceedings is filed as part of the record in this case. The Court certifies that at all times during the trial of this case the defendant was personally present and her attorney was likewise personally present and capably represented the defendant.
