CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Ashleigh A. Stover, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Stover's application for licensure by examination to practice as a practical nurse in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. By application received April 10, 2014, Ashleigh A. Stover applied for licensure by examination to practice as a practical nurse in the Commonwealth of Virginia. Her primary state of residence is Virginia.
- 2. On September 7, 2012, Ms. Stover was convicted in the General District Court for the City of Virginia Beach, Virginia, of one count of petit larceny and one count of credit card fraud, both misdemeanors involving moral turpitude. She was sentenced to 365 days incarceration with 335 days suspended for one year, and was ordered to pay \$398.00 in costs.
 - 3. All court costs were paid by November 13, 2012.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").
 - 2. Ms. Stover otherwise meets the requirements of § 54.1-3020 of the Code.

CONSENT

Ashleigh A. Stover, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

- 1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
- 2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) et seq. of the Code;
- 3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
 - 4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
- 5. She admits the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
- 6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her application for licensure to practice as a practical nurse in Virginia.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. The application of Ashleigh A. Stover for licensure by examination as a practical nurse is hereby APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the National Counsel Licensure Examination Practical Nurse (NCLEX-PN), Ms. Stover shall be issued an unrestricted license to practice as a practical nurse in Virginia.
 - 2. Ashleigh A. Stover is hereby REPRIMANDED.
- 3. Ms. Stover shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a practical nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.
