NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), Abigail Lebron-Cannon, R.N., who holds License No. 0001-223718 which expires on July 31, 2016, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on January 28, 2016, at 11:00 a.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Lebron-Cannon will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Lebron-Cannon has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Lebron-Cannon desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Ms. Lebron-Cannon may have violated certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the Order of the Board entered on February 4, 2010 (“Board’s Order”), as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Abigail Lebron-Cannon, R.N. may have violated Term No. 1 of the Board's Order, which required her to remain in compliance with all terms and conditions of the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP") for the period specified by the HPMP, in that Ms. Lebron-Cannon was dismissed from the HPMP on or about September 24, 2014, for falsifying worksite monitor information, forging worksite monitor reports, and changing her workplace unit/department without HPMP approval.
