ORDER

JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11), a panel of the Virginia

Board of Nursing ("Board") held a formal administrative hearing on July 19, 2017, in Henrico County,

Virginia, to inquire into evidence that Geisha Yvonne Scott, R.M.A., may have violated certain laws and

regulations governing the practice of medication aides in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Geisha Yvonne Scott, R.M.A., did not appear at this proceeding and was not represented by legal

counsel.

NOTICE

By letter dated June 16, 2017, the Board sent a Notice of Formal Hearing ("Notice") to Ms. Scott

notifying her that a formal administrative hearing would be held on July 19, 2017. The Notice was sent

by certified and first class mail to the legal address of record on file with the Board. Accordingly, the

panel Chair concluded that adequate notice was provided to Ms. Scott and the formal hearing proceeded

in her absence.

Upon consideration of the evidence, the Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and

Conclusions of Law and issues the Order contained herein.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On January 20, 2015, the Board issued Registration Number 0031-008353 to Geisha

Yvonne Scott, R.M.A., to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia. Said

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registration is scheduled to expire on August 31, 2017. At all times relevant hereto, said registration was in full force and effect.

- 2. During the course of her employment at Hill's Home for Adults, Chesapeake, Virginia, on two occasions between August 2016 and October 18, 2016, Ms. Scott had sexual contact with a resident, to which Ms. Scott admitted.
 - 3. Ms. Scott's employment was terminated on October 18, 2016.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of Virginia Code § 54.1-3007(2) and (5) and 18 VAC 90-60-120(2)(j) of the Regulations Governing the Registration of Medication Aides.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Board of Nursing hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. The registration of Geisha Yvonne Scott, R.M.A., to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia is REVOKED.
 - 2. The registration of Geisha Yvonne Scott, R.M.A., will be recorded as REVOKED.
- 3. Pursuant to Virginia Code § 54.1-2408.2, should Geisha Yvonne Scott, R.M.A., seek reinstatement of her registration after three years, the reinstatement of Ms. Scott's registration shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members at a formal administrative proceeding convened by the Board. At such time, the burden shall be on Ms. Scott to demonstrate that she is safe and competent to return to practice as a medication aide. Ms. Scott shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement and/or renewal of the registration prior to issuance of the registration to resume practice.
