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CONSENT ORDER

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JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Allura Fae Woodard, C.N.A., as evidenced by their signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to an informal conference, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Woodard's certificate to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Allura Fae Woodard, C.N.A., was issued Certificate Number 1401-154069 to practice as a nurse aide on July 5, 2012, which is scheduled to expire on July 31, 2017.
2. Ms. Woodard violated Virginia Code § 54.1-3007(5) in that during the course of her employment at Memory Lane Assisted Living Facility, Woodstock, Virginia, on September 8, 2016, Ms. Woodard used inappropriate language in the presence of Resident A.
3. Ms. Woodward violate Virginia Code § 54.1-3007(2) and 18 VAC 90-25-100(2)(a) of the Regulations Governing Certified Nurse Aides in that during the course of her employment at Memory Lane, on September 7, 2016, Ms. Woodard acted outside the scope of her practice as a nurse aide by applying a topical analgesic to Resident B, after being informed that doing so was outside the scope of practice for nurse aides at the facility.
4. The facility terminated Ms. Woodard's employment.

### CONSENT

Allura Fae Woodard, C.N.A., by affixing her signature to this Consent Order, agrees to the following:

1. I have been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me or my certificate except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia Code § 2.2-4000 *et seq.*;
3. I acknowledge that I have the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Board; the right to representation by counsel; and the right to cross-examine witnesses against me;
4. I waive my right to an informal conference;
5. I admit to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waive my right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any sanction imposed hereunder in any future judicial or administrative proceeding in which the Board is a party;
6. I consent to the entry of the following Order affecting my certification to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

### ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Board of Nursing hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. Alluria Fae Woodard, C.N.A. is REPRIMANDED
2. Allura Fae Woodard, C.N.A. shall comply with all laws and regulations governing the practice of certified nurse aides in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

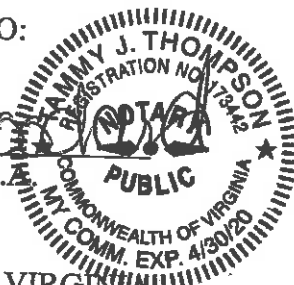
