Upon entry of this Order, the certificate of Janice Marie Love, C.N.A., will be recorded as suspended and

no longer current and valid. Should Janice Marie Love, C.N.A., seek reinstatement of her certificate pursuant to

Virginia Code § 54.1-2409, she shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement of the

certificate prior to issuance of the certificate to resume practice.

The presentence report was considered and filed as part of the record in accordance with the provisions of Code §19.2-299.

A Community Corrections Alternative Program report was filed.

Pursuant to the provisions of Code § 19.2-298.01 the applicable discretionary sentencing guidelines and the guidelines worksheets were reviewed and considered by the Court and are ordered filed as part of the record.

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Before pronouncing the sentence, the Court inquired if the defendant desired to make a statement and if the defendant desired to advance any reason why judgment should not be pronounced.

The Court **SENTENCES** the defendant to:

Incarceration in the Virginia Department of Corrections for the term of:

- 20 years on each charge of Financially Exploit Mentally Incapacitated Person-2 counts. The terms shall run concurrently with each other.
- 20 years on each charge of Credit Card Theft-2 counts. The terms shall run concurrently with each other.
- 5 years on the charge of Credit Card Fraud >\$200 in 6 Month Period.
- 10 years on each charge of Forgery-7 counts. The terms shall run concurrently with each other.
- 10 years on each charge of Uttering a Forged Check-7 counts. The terms shall run concurrently with each other.

The total sentence imposed is 65 years.

The Court SUSPENDS all but 2 years and 4 months of the Credit Card Theft-2 counts sentence and ALL of the Financially Exploit Mentally Incapacitated Person-2 counts sentence, ALL of the Credit Card Fraud >\$200 in 6 Month Period sentence, ALL of the Forgery-7 counts sentence and ALL of the Uttering a Forged Check-7 counts sentences upon the following condition(s):

- 1. Good Behavior. The defendant shall be of good behavior for 65 years.
- 2. Supervised Probation. The defendant is placed on supervised probation. The defendant shall be on probation until released by the probation officer. Probation under the supervision of a probation officer shall commence upon sentencing unless the defendant is remanded to custody at sentencing then it shall commence upon release from incarceration. The defendant shall comply with all the rules, terms and requirements set by the probation officer.
- 3. Jail Time Delayed. The defendant shall report to the Jail on 05/05/2017 at 9:00am.

Credit for time served. The defendant sentenced to a term of confinement in a correctional facility shall be given credit for time spent in confinement while awaiting trial pursuant to Code § 53.1-187.

Costs. The defendant shall pay costs pursuant to statute.

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DNA. The defendant shall provide a DNA sample pursuant to §§ 19.2-310.2 and 19.2-310.3 unless a sample was previously taken from the person as indicated by the Local Inmate Data System (LIDS).
