ORDER OF SUSPENSION


Section 54.1-104 of the Code of Virginia authorizes the Department of Health Professions to suspend the license, certificate, registration, or any other authority issued to any person who submits a check, money draft, or similar instrument for payment of a fee required by statute or regulation which is not honored by the bank or financial institution named thereon. The suspension shall become effective ten (10) days following delivery by certified mail of written notice of the dishonor and the impending suspension to such person's last known address. Suspension under this provision shall be exempt from the Administrative Process Act.

An instrument dated October 28, 2008 was submitted by Selina Jimenez for payment of a \$130.00 Endorsement IN Fee. The financial institution upon which it was drawn did not honor this instrument. Selina Jimenez was notified of this by letter dated March 10, 2009 and advised of the impending suspension. At least ten days have passed since delivery by certified mail of that letter.

It is therefore **ORDERED** that license number **0002079378**, issued to **Selina Jimenez** is hereby **SUSPENDED**.

This **ORDER** shall be made available for public inspection and notification upon request.

Dear Ms. Jimenez:

Our certified letter dated March 10, 2009 notified you that the check you presented for \$130.00 was not honored by the financial institution upon which it was drawn. This check was offered to pay fees established by the Board of Nursing.

Section 54.1-104 of the Code of Virginia empowers the Department of Health Professions to suspend a license or certificate of anyone who submits a check, money draft, or similar instrument for payment of a fee required by statute or regulation which is not honored by the bank or financial institution. The suspension shall become effective ten (10) days following delivery by certified mail of written notice of the dishonor and the impending suspension to such person's address.

You are hereby informed that the Department has suspended your license, and you are no longer legally eligible to practice as a Licensed Practical Nurse. Section 54.1-111 makes the practice of a profession without a valid license a criminal act punishable by a fine and incarceration, and repeated violations may constitute a felony. Therefore, you are strongly advised to immediately cease and desist from practice until you take action necessary to have your license reinstated.

To have your license reinstated, you must remit fees totaling \$165.00 by certified check, money order, or cashier's check made payable to the Treasurer of Virginia, along with a copy of this letter, to the Department of Health Professions.
