served by mail, three days are added to that period.

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REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION OF AGENCY SUBORDINATE

Jurisdiction and Procedural History

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4019 and 54.1-2400(10), Jane Elliott, R.N., Ph.D., serving as

Agency Subordinate of the Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board"), held an informal conference on

March 15, 2017 in Henrico County, Virginia, to inquire into evidence that Savannah P. Fletcher,

C.N.A., may have violated certain laws and regulations governing the practice of certified nurse aides

in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Ms. Fletcher did not appear at this proceeding and was not represented by legal counsel.

Upon consideration of the evidence, the Agency Subordinate makes the following Findings of

Fact and Conclusions of Law and recommends that the Board adopt the following Order.

Notice

By letter dated February 15, 2017, the Board sent a Notice of Informal Conference ("Notice")

to Ms. Fletcher notifying her that an informal conference would be held on March 15, 2017. The

Notice was sent by certified and first class mail to the legal address of record on file with the Board.

The certified mail receipt was signed by another individual and returned to the Board office on

February 25, 2017. The Notice sent by first class mail was not returned to the Board office.

Accordingly, the Agency Subordinate concluded that adequate notice was provided to Ms. Fletcher

and the informal conference proceeded in her absence.

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## Recommended Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law

- 1. Savannah P. Fletcher, C.N.A., was issued Certificate Number 1401-167058 to practice as a nurse aide on May 29, 2014, which is scheduled to expire on May 31, 2017. At all times relevant to the findings herein, said certificate was in full force and effect.
- 2. Savannah P. Fletcher, C.N.A., violated Virginia Code § 54.1-54.1-3007(2), (5), and (8) and 18 VAC 90-25-100(2)(e) of the Regulations Governing Certified Nurse Aides in that during the course of her employment with Highland Ridge Rehab Center, Dublin, Virginia, on March 26, 2016, after a resident with dementia had thrown and smeared feces around her room, she took part in laughing at and making fun of the resident. In addition, she videoed two other nurse aides with the feces and posted the video on social media.
- 3. During the facility's investigation of this matter, Ms. Fletcher acknowledged taking part in the event. Ms. Fletcher's employment with Highland Ridge was terminated as a result of this incident.
- 4. Ms. Fletcher did not respond to contact attempts by an investigator for the Department of Health Professions.
- 5. Finding of Fact and Conclusion of Law No. 2 constitutes a Finding of Abuse pursuant to 42 CFR § 483.156(b)(2) and (c)(1)(iv)(D) of the Code of Federal Regulations.

## Recommended Order

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Agency Subordinate recommends that the Board issue an Order as follows:

- 1. The certificate of Savannah P. Fletcher, C.N.A., to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia is REVOKED.
  - 2. The certificate of Ms. Fletcher will be recorded as REVOKED.

3. A Finding of Abuse shall be ENTERED against Savannah P. Fletcher, C.N.A., in the

Virginia Nurse Aide Registry pursuant to 42 CFR § 483.13(c)(1)(ii)(B) and 42 CFR § 483.156(b)(2)

and (c)(1)(iv)(D). This finding prohibits Ms. Fletcher's employment as a certified nurse aide in any

long-term care facility that receives Medicare or Medicaid reimbursement, according to 42 CFR §

483.13(c)(1)(ii)(B).
